





Saving water in the garden.

In hot and dry weather water used outdoors can amount to 50 per cent of total usage. In the UK its possible however to have a beautiful and productive garden using very little mains water. No matter how much it rains in Britain we always seem to need more water for our plants and gardens. By collecting your rainwater in an underground water tank you will have a constant supply of water. Once your system is set up there is no end to the uses of water you save. You can

connect a pressure washer to the tap outlet and use the rain water to wash your car or even clean your patio. Recycling your rain water has many advantages first being; its free you can store as much as you want and reuse it how you want. Second is that rain water is softer than tap water which means that if you were to using the water for your garden then some plants respond better to rain water than tap water.

WHY HARVEST RAINWATER?

We use 70 % more water today than we did 40 years ago.

By reducing our water usage we will – Save money and Reduce possibility of a drought which will lead to a hosepipe ban. Reduce the damage which is done to wildlife in wetlands reservoir and rivers.





Osteoporosis And Menopause And The Benefits Of Exercise

Menopause and Exercise.

Unfortunately ladies it will happen to us all at some point. Another thing to contend with as we get older. As if having to give birth isn't enough. But it doesn't have to take control of your body. Get in there first. Beginning around the mid-thirties, hormone production in the ovaries starts to slow down. It slows down even more when you hit your 40s and you may experience hormone fluctuations until you go through menopause which happens around 50 for the average woman. What many women don't like about this process are the symptoms and problems that come with these shifting hormones such as:


Osteoporosis

- Hot flushes
- Depression, stress and anxiety
- Sleep disorders
- Irritability
- Osteoporosis
- Cardiovascular disease
- Weight Gain

Low back pain can become severe and prevalent, as well as neck pain, which is all caused by tiny fractures of the spinal bones.

avoided through exercise and nutrition. Weight Gain being the most common is often simply due to: Reduced activity. Women often exercise less when they enter menopause, which can lead to weight gain. Decreased metabolism. One reason metabolism declines with age is the loss of muscle mass. Muscle burns more calories than fat, so when

you lose that muscle (about 1/2-lb a year if you don't preserve it with weight training/exercise), you don't burn as many calories.

Increase in calories. As metabolism drops, many people don't adjust their calories accordingly, which often leads to weight gain.

Osteoporosis

This is thinning of the bones that can happen in males and females.

Most of these symptoms can be reduced or eased, if not completely

While oestrogen levels are one factor that determines the health of the skeleton, many more factors play a role in maintaining bone health. Two of the most important factors are physical activity and nutrition. These factors are no less important after menopause.

Physical activity plays a very important role in keeping our bones strong. Many studies have shown that physically active women have higher bone mass than inactive women and that physically active persons experience fewer fractures even if they have osteoporosis. Studies have also shown that when people engage in a certain types and amounts of physical activity their bone mass may increase, or at least be protected against severe decreases.

It is recommended to do thirty to sixty minutes, three to five times a week, of weight-bearing endurance activities (e.g. jogging, stair climbing and aerobics), combined with resistance exercise (weight lifting).

The 2012 Summer Olympic Games will be held in London from 27 July to 12 August 2012, followed by the 2012 Paralympic Games from 29 August to 9 September.

How many times has London hosted the Olympics?

London hosted the Olympic games in 1908 and 1948.

How many countries are expected to take part in the London 2012 Olympics?

We expect 205 nations to take part in 300 events at the Olympic Games in 2012. 147 nations will take part in the Paralympic Games.





The Rings

The Olympic Rings are five interlocking rings that stand for the five original continents, (Africa, America, Asia, Australia, and Europe) and the athletes from around the world.

The colours of the rings are blue, yellow, black, green, and red respectively. They were chosen because at least one of these colours is found on the flag of every nation.

The Flag

On the Olympic flag, the rings appear on a white background. At the Olympic Games, the flag is brought into the stadium during the opening ceremony. After its arrival, the flag is hoisted up the flagpole. It must fly in the stadium during the whole of the Games. When the flag is lowered at the closing ceremony, it signals the end of the Games.

Motte

The motto of th Olympic Games is "Swifter, Higher, Stronger".

These three words encourage the athlete to give his or her best during competition, and to view this effort as a victory in itself. To better understand the motto, we can compare it with the following well-known phrase:

The most important thing is not to win but to take part!

The Flame

The Olympic flame is one of the best-known features of the Games.

From the moment the flame is lit to the moment it goes out, a very precise ritual is laid down:



The lighting

In memory of the Olympic Games' origins, the flame is lit in Olympia, Greece, some months before the opening of the Games. The Olympic flame can only be lit by the sun's rays.

The relay route

The torch is carried by relay from Olympia to the host city of the Games.

Arrival at the stadium

The day of the opening of the Games, the flame enters the stadium. With the lighting of the cauldron by the last relay runner the flame is transferred from the torch to the place where it will continue to burn for the entire length of the Games. The flame is extinguished on the final day of the Games at the closing ceremony.



Women were first allowed to participate in 1900 at the second modern Olympic Games.

Because of World War I and World War II. there were no Olympic Games in 1916, 1940, or 1944.

Tennis was played at the Olympics until 1924, then reinstituted in 1988.

Though Russia had sent a few athletes to compete in the 1908 and 1912 Olympic Games, they did not compete again until the 1952 Games.

Motor boating was an official sport at the 1908 Olympics.

The word "gymnasium" comes from the Greek root "gymnos" meaning nude; the literal meaning of "gymnasium" is "school for naked exercise." Athletes in the ancient Olympic Games would participate in the nude.

The first recorded ancient Olympic Games were held in 776 BCE with only one event - the stade. The stade was a unit of measurement (about 600 feet) that also became the name of the footrace because it was the distance run. Since the track for the stade (race) was a stade (length), the location of the race became the stadium.

Polo was played at the Olympics in 1900, 1908, 1920, 1924, and 1936.

The last Olympic gold medals that were made entirely out of gold were awarded in 1912.

The first opening ceremonies were held during the 1908 Olympic Games in London.

First Modern Champion

James B. Connolly (United States), winner of the hop, step, and jump (the first final event in the 1896 Olympics), was the first Olympic champion of the modern Olympic Games.

A City, Not a Country

When choosing locations for the Olympic Games, the IOC specifically gives the honor of holding the Games to a city rather than a country.

The Olympic medals are designed especially for each individual Olympic Games by the host city's organizing committee. Each medal must be at least three millimeters thick and 60 millimeters in diameter. Also, the gold and silver Olympic medals must be made out of 92.5 percent silver, with the gold medal covered in six grams of gold.

During the first several modern Olympics, the marathon was always an approximate distance. In 1908, the British royal family requested that the marathon start at the Windsor Castle so that the royal children could witness its start. The distance from the Windsor Castle to the Olympic Stadium was 42,195 meters (or 26 miles and 385 yards). In 1924, this distance became the standardized length of a marathon.
















Willaston - Hadlow Road Station - Burton -Hampstons Well - Denhall Ness - The Wirral Way -Willaston. (Walking distance 7 miles)

Like most walks in Wirral this takes you through very pleasant quiet country lanes and also includes a deserted stretch of coastline.

Leave Hadlow Station and turn left into Hadlow Road. Follow the winding road for approximately 12 minutes until you reach the Chester High Road, (A540). Cross the main road and bear slightly right to go down Dunstan Lane. You will have now reached a very pleasant byway which, after passing Mudhouse Lane, leads you to the village street of Burton.

The beautiful village of Burton has some of the best architectural houses and the church was almost entirely rebuilt in 1721 - time has almost stood still here. Many of the houses are built of half timber and red sandstone. In 1906 Burton Manor House was rebuilt for one of Gladstone's sons who was our Prime Minister at that time. Opposite the gates of the Manor is a thatched farmhouse which in 1663 Thomas Wilson was born who became bishop of Sodor and Man. Thomas dedicated his life to provide schools so that all could be educated. Once past this point turn left along Station Road and you will pass Hampstons Well on the left hand side of the road. The residents used this spring as a source of water. Further down the road you will pass over the railway and pass Denhall Lane and will reach the Dee Estuary. You will come across a few houses in the hamlet of Denhall and once passed these you will have a tranguil walk along the shoreline. Eventually the path leads you through a group of houses, after the passing the left

house turn right and walk towards an estate of houses, heading in the direction of the houses on the right. You will have now reached a step-stile with the houses on your left. Keep going forwards to cross another step-stile, you will have now entered a sandy lane which passes under a railway bridge. This leads you into a byway you must turn right and will soon arrive into the hamlet of Ness.

When you finally reach the Wheatsheaf Inn pub where you deserve a drink. After refreshments look across Neston Road for a large white house called Swan Cottage. This was formerly the village blacksmith's shop and his flames at night were visable down the Dee Estuary. This gave ships a beacon to follow and later was know as the "Beacon of Cheshire". The blacksmiths daughter Lady Emma Hamilton was to become the mistress of Admiral Lord Nelson. Leave Ness and turn left into Mill Lane, after leaving the houses you will arrive into countryside and pass Ness Wood, this lane brings you back to the A540 Chester High Road. Cross over to Damhead Lane and you will come across an old sandstone bridge, look right for the access to the Wirral Way. Turn right at the bottom of the steps. After walking for 10 minutes you. will arrive back at Hadlow Station.


