



"Rover Watch"



The pressure is mounting on rookie Tranmere manager Rob Edwards following a winless month which saw his side drop important points in a most frustrating manner. Rovers, struggling to reacquaint with the fourth division, have been toothless in attack and frail at the back; a deadly concoction condemning the club to it's worst league position in a generation.

Tranmere, who managed to score just once in a barren five-game stretch throughout September, lay in 22nd place after eleven league games, a nadir unmatched since 1987, when only a final day victory over Exeter City prevented an ignominious slide into the Conference. A quarter of a century on, and an apparent failure to properly retool following relegation last season has Rovers reeling and fans facing the realistic prospect of another battle for survival.

One saving grace at present is Edwards' men continuing to create chances and, though sporadically, demonstrate glimpses of smart passing play. However, this occasional positivity is offset by a chronic inability to take advantage of said chances and convert them into goals, the currency of successful teams. A recent away game with Hartlepool illustrated this hardship, as Tranmere, in command for vast periods of the contest, displayed some woeful finishing and, unable to put their opponents to the sword, were forced to settle for an unsatisfying 0-0 draw.

Similarly, against Newport just three days later, the Superwhites played in neat interchanging patterns for the first fifteen minutes but, without lodging a breakthrough, quickly became frustrated, disjointed and incoherent in attack. The Welsh visitors grew in stature as Rovers shrunk in despondency, and the resultant goalless draw was ultimately hard-earned.

In many respects, Tranmere resemble a team in transition, and a slow and painful one at that. Once again, a home game with Exeter, in mid-September, provided fresh perspective; Rovers coming unstuck against a seasoned team exceedingly literate in football at this level. Exeter, the club where Edwards cut his teeth as a coach under highly-regarded manager Paul Tisdale, were slick, sophisticated and disciplined. They knew their identity and principles, and stuck to them impressively in beating Tranmere 2-1. Ultimately, the idea is for Edwards to imitate Tisdale and for Tranmere to become as calm, confident and composed as Exeter. This particular game illustrated the distance between the present struggle and that future vision, and served as a real wake-up call for

It sent a shockwave through the entire operation, with Tranmere slumping to consecutive away defeats against Carlisle and Bury shortly thereafter; the forwards failing to make an impact and the defence looking ever more suspect in successive 1-0 and 2-0 losses that left Rovers' just two places from rock bottom of the Football League.

everybody associated with the Wirral club.

At present, the way Tranmere attack and defend set pieces provides a fitting microcosm of why the club is struggling. In an attacking sense, Rovers rarely test the opposition from corners or free-kicks around the penalty box, but, defensively, seem almost comically prone to conceding from any such situation. This blend of offensive profligacy and defensive instability has irked Edwards, who recently explained how "we're getting punished at set plays and don't look like scoring from ours."

At Carlisle, Tranmere allowed rival striker David Amoo to rise above four defensive markers at a corner and nod home what proved to be the decisive goal. Rovers, defying convention, had nobody defending the back post, exactly where Amoo's effort flew into the back of the net.

Then, a week later, both Bury goals came from corners, with Kelvin Etuhu and Daniel Nardiello exploiting statuesque defending to score into the same area of the goal usually secured by post-quarding defenders.

In two games, Rovers conceded three goals, and dropped at least two points, simply by virtue of not marking sufficiently at corners and not placing a defender on the line, which is somewhat elementary.

In attempting to explain these teething problems, Edwards pointed to the relative inexperience of his side. "We have some young players who are learning on the job," said the boss. "The centre-halves are young. The left-back is young. We have young players throughout the side. We need some older players."

Indeed, after spending the past twenty-five years playing in higher divisions, including the last thirteen in League One, the inexperience and lack of proven quality in the Tranmere squad is alarming. Perhaps this summer's decision to cut costs and dispense with the services of key players, such as top goalscorer Ryan Lowe, was taken too quickly, and with too harsh an intent. In this regard, Edwards hasn't been dealt the best hand and, as a result, doesn't have an abundance of tools with which to dig Rovers out of a rut of historical proportions.

However, the fact remains that, through his first thirteen games in charge, Edwards has the worst winning percentage (15%) of any permanent Tranmere manager since Bill Ridding in the early-1940s. Similarly, the club, a member of the Football League for 93 unabridged years, has rarely teetered on the brink of the Conference with such solemnity as is presently the case.





I've received an email from HMRC saying that I'm due a tax refund.

What should I do with it?

Answer

Firstly, HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) would never send notifications of a tax rebate by email, or ask you to disclose personal or payment information by email. So this email already sounds suspicious!

Also, look at the sender's email address. Fraudsters often have email accounts with HMRC or revenue names in them (such as 'refunds@hmrc.org.uk'). These email addresses are used to mislead you. However be aware, fraudsters can falsify (spoof) the 'from' address to look like a legitimate HMRC address (for example '@hmrc. gov.uk'), so the email address isn't conclusive.

But the safest way of dealing with this is not to open it or click on any attachment or links, and send it to phishing@hmrc.gsi.gov.uk.

HMRC should reply to confirm whether it is a scam email or not.

High Income Child Benefit Charge Letter Question

I have recently received a letter from HMRC saying that I have not disclosed my High Income Child Benefit Charge on my tax return. What should I do?

Answer

HMRC have recently been sending individuals letters, stating that they believe the High Income Child Benefit Charge has not been declared on their 2012/13 tax returns.

In the event you receive a communication from HMRC that you believe to be incorrect, don't ignore it. You should contact HMRC for clarification or ask your accountant to do this on your behalf.

It is worth highlighting that many individuals have received these letters in error though. Supposedly, HMRC's records have ignored if:

- no child benefit was actually received in 2012/13
- the highest earner has already paid the HICBC
- the taxpayer's 'adjusted net income' is less than £50,000. Actual income can be reduced for trading losses, gift aid donations and pension contributions to arrive at 'adjusted net income'.

Contact your local TaxAssist Accountant if you'd like them review the letter against your affairs or if you'd like them to liaise with HMRC on your behalf.

Gingersnap Prune Cheesecake Bites

Servings: 12

1 1/4 cups 2 percent plain Greek yogurt

2 tablespoons coconut sugar Cooking spray

12 small gingersnap cookies

1/2 cup Plum Amazins 2 tablespoons minced candied ginger





WIRRAL FIRMS SCOOP PRESTIGIOUS ENERGY EFFICIENCY AWARD FOR NATIONAL TRUST PROJECT

Two Wirral companies have won a prestigious national energy efficiency award for their work on the UK's largest ever marine source heat pump.

The 300kW pump at the National Trust's Plas Newydd mansion in Anglesey utilises the tidal currents of the Menai Strait to provide all the power needed to heat the property.

The marine source heat pump was manufactured by renewable energy manufacturer Stiebel Eltron UK and installed by Kimpton Energy Services, both of whom are headquartered in Bromborough.

Plas Newydd, built in the 18th Century, was formerly the National Trust's biggest oil consumer – using up to 138,000 litres of oil annually at a cost of around £70,000.

In May, the Trust unveiled the groundbreaking project, the first of five schemes to be completed in a £3.5million pilot phase of its Renewable Energy Investment.

It has now been named Commercial Project of the Year in the Energy Efficiency and Renewables Awards at London's Kensington Roof Gardens.

The Plas Newydd marine source heat pump pumps a small amount of sea water from the Menai Strait through a network of pipes to and from a heat exchanger on the shore, and then up 30 metres of cliff face to the mansion's boiler house.

Mark McManus, Managing Director of Stiebel Eltron UK, said: "We are absolutely delighted that Plas Newydd has been recognised for the commissioning of this ground-breaking project.

"The installation of the pump is transforming energy usage at Plas Newydd, dramatically improving its CO2 performance and saving tens of thousands of pounds a year that were previously being spent on oil.

"It has been a hugely rewarding project for everyone concerned and the biggest project Stiebel Eltron has been involved with in the UK."

Richard Kimpton, Managing Director of Kimpton Energy Services, said: "Plas Newydd was a complex and challenging project which involved us working around the tides in order to move equipment and carry out the installation.

"The design phase of the project was incredibly demanding and had to ensure that our calculations met the criteria of the Government's Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) which stipulates specific performance requirements."

"The Plas Newydd installation was an extremely innovative project involving a team of more than 40 people and it is fantastic that it has now been recognised in these important national awards."

The installation of the marine source heat pump at Plas Newydd forms part of the National Trust's Grow Your Own Energy programme which includes targets of reducing energy usage by 20 per cent and meeting half of its energy requirements through renewable energy.

The project saw a number of firsts – the first marine source heat pump of its type in the UK, the biggest at 300kW and the first in open sea rather than a harbour.

Adam Ellis-Jones, Assistant Director for Operations in Wales for the National Trust, said: "With the Irish Sea right on the doorstep of Plas Newydd, a marine source heat pump was the best option for us.

Other key partners in the project have included SEACAMS, led by the School of Ocean Sciences at Bangor University, and DIO per cent renewable electricity supplier Good Energy which launched the Renewable Energy Investment Programme with the National Trust last year.

Right: 1897. The little girl is standing in front of the Irby Mill which had ceased operating in 1875. This had been the second mill in the immediate area, built between 1709 and 1725, with the first mill dating back to at least 1291 and erected on the other side of Hill Bark Road. Millers cottage can be seen in the background.



promenading on The Parade at Parkgate. with some of them walking along the slightly raised wall - just as families do today. The building on the left is The Moorings, which is still there today and is one of only two houses on The Parade which has a gable end fronting the river.

Below: 1906. Over 100 years ago this was a popular café for cyclists, being on a main junction for roads from Chester to Heswall and Birkenhead to Wales (to the right). There were no give-way signs then due to the lack of traffic. Today it is known as 'Two Mills' or 'Welsh crossroads'. The cast iron mile post on the right was erected in 1896. The telegraph poles, which disappear into the distance must have been 30 - 40ft high.

Above: 1889. Children playing a game are probably from Parkgate Infants School which was behind St. Thomas's Church in the square. They are seen in front of the Union Hotel later to be renamed the 'Ship Inn'.





Left 1892. Looking down Dee View Road Heswall the people are standing by the entrance to the Dee View Inn. In 1974 the beer retailer was Joseph Ellis who was also listed as a smallware dealer. It was taken over by Birkenhead Brewery. The building beyond was once a branch Mackie and Gladstone and the site now forms part of the car park.

Right 1902. The horse and cart is proceeding over the stone bridge at Saughall Massie. This bridge was the first to be built by Thomas Brassey in 1829, who was born in the Wirral village of Burton - the bridge has a blue badge with all the relevant details to commemmorate the fact.



Left 1898. Irby Hill Farm in Irby Hill Road Irby had their own water supply, as the girl is seen pumping water - others had to go to the nearest well which was in Frankby. These farm buildings were converted into houses.

Below 1894. Looking down Neston High Street from The Cross where the drinking fountain can be seen which was erected in 1882 at the expense of Christopher Bushell.



Liverpool's UNESCO World heritage Site waterfront, which includes the Cunard Building, will provide a unique backdrop for the "Three Queens, One Magnificent City" spectacular which organisers expect up to 1million spectators to attend.

Preparing to accommodate the three Queens requires meticulous and detailed planning. As well as being the biggest ships ever built for Cunard, the fleet includes the largest passenger ship ever to sail the Mersey as well as two sister ships which each top 90.000 tons.

The complex marine operations plan is being prepared by a team including Commodore of the Cunard fleet Christopher Rynd; Captain Steve Gallimore, the Port of Liverpool Harbour Master; and Mr Chris Booker, Chairman of Liverpool Pilots Limited and the Events River Pilot.

A series of carefully choreographed ship movements will take place in various parts of the Mersey from Crosby and New Brighton to points off Albert Dock and Woodside. The Liverpool Pilots are utilising their sophisticated ship simulator to assist in planning the manoeuvres.

Commodore Rynd said: "With the unique backdrop of Liverpool's world-famous waterfront, and the capacity on both sides of the Mersey to accommodate tens of thousands of spectators, I believe this will be a most spectacular gathering of the Three Queens. I am excited by the prospect of bringing the Fleet to its spiritual home and I am impressed by the level of engagement and collaboration between the partners involved to make it all possible."

Cllr Wendy Simon, Liverpool City Council Cabinet Member with responsibility for Culture and Tourism, said: "The arrival of the Three Queens in the Mersey next May will be a spectacular and memorable event and one which will present Liverpool's credentials as a truly world-class cruise port destination with a unique maritime history and heritage to a global audience. The Fleet is cominq!"




