ROVER WATCH

END OF SEASON

Tranmere endured another disappointing end to a season in May, as inopportune defeats derailed their hopes of promotion. What began as a campaign of feint optimism ended with familiar pain, to the frustration of diehard fans who have now waited twenty-five years to see Rovers win a trophy of any description.

A poor loss to Welling, detailed in last month's column, heaped enormous pressure on Tranmere as they fought for a playoff spot. With four games remaining, they remained in the top five, but other clubs had multiple games in hand, making even the most positive fan nervous for the final run-in. Ultimately, Rovers ran out of steam when it mattered most, with their less equipped rivals enjoying an inspired run of form.

Tranmere managed to beat 1-0 Torquay as April began, with Michael Higdon notching the only goal in a dull game on the English Riviera. That result temporarily strengthened Rovers' hold on a playoff spot, but Braintree beat Grimsby, and Eastleigh triumphed over Barrow later that week to close the gap again.

A pressure-packed local derby with Wrexham followed, and only a victory would really suffice for Tranmere. Once again, the club received incredible support, as 7,541 flocked to Prenton Park for a fifth division encounter. Yet, as has too often been the case in recent years, those loyal supporters went home frustrated as Rovers failed to deliver the goods.

Kayden Jackson opened the scoring for Wrexham after fifteen minutes, increasing tension on Wirral, and Tranmere struggled to muster a serious response. Momentum wasn't forthcoming, but Rovers won a penalty with twelve minutes remaining. James Norwood, a rare shining light this season, thundered it home to equalise, although Tranmere required all three points to seriously boost their playoff credentials. Cruelly, Wrexham snatched a winner with just five minutes left, as Sean Newton headed into the top corner from a set play. The visitors emerged victorious, and a deathly pall settled over the Rovers fanbase, which felt that another fruitless season was all but over.

A trip to Eastleigh followed, and both sides looked tired in a tense game. Braintree scored a late winner at Wrexham, jeopardising Tranmere's chances further. In fact, with three minutes remaining, Rovers' season was on life support. Only a victory would ensure their fight went down to the final day. Chances were few and far between, as fans felt resigned to defeat in the promotion push. Then, like so

many times this season, Norwood popped up out of nowhere to score another crucial goal, looping a header over the goalkeeper in the eighty-seventh minute to keep the Superwhites' feint playoff chances alive.

On the final day, Tranmere had to beat Grimsby, hope that Braintree lost to Altrincham, and wish that Eastleigh didn't win by a hefty margin to improve their inferior goal difference. The fans and players put on a brave face and tried to conjure some optimism, but it never felt authentic, and it seemed like Rovers were always battling insurmountable odds.

News quickly filtered through from Essex that Braintree took a seventeenth minute lead, before adding two more goals either side of half-time. Steve Jennings scored as Tranmere finished with a 1-0 win, but it simply wasn't enough, as another great crowd of 6,637 trudged out of Prenton Park in despondent mood. Another campaign came and went, and still those fans were left waiting for their day in the sun.

Ultimately then, this was a season of failure for Rovers, who should have challenged more seriously for the league title, let alone a playoff place. For a club of this magnitude to slip out of the Football League was embarrassing, but failing to secure an immediate return is perhaps even more hurtful. Tranmere Rovers is a proud club with a tremendous heritage. By rights, the facilities and fanbase make it a third division club at worst. To see it languishing in the fifth tier is painful, but there is no use feeling sorry for ourselves. Now, Rovers must learn from their mistakes, rectify them over the summer, and seek improvement across the board next season, which will be hugely important in the club's history.





Scammy Spammy Calls & Texts - A Guide to keeping yourself safe.

Recently it has come to light that there is a new scam going around that is involving criminal gangs ringing your mobile number from an **0870**, or **0854** number – however by giving one or two rings, inevitably, curiosity gets the better of you and you call back.

Unfortunately that is **EXACTLY** what they are hoping you do, and this could end up costing you a lot more than your usual bill.

The scam in question involves you calling back these numbers to see what this is about, and ending up being charged anything between £75.00 - £300.00 for just returning the call.

This is sadly becoming more and more popular as the unsuspecting consumer falls victim. Action Fraud and Network providers are taking steps to prevent this from happening to anyone but as of yet have not found a resolution, there is no recourse from this as you have willingly dialled the number back yourself so sadly will be left with the rather large bill to pay.

However, there are ways to prevent yourself from becoming Victim to these type of scams. By following the tips below you can ensure that you become a consumer crusader and help in the fight against these thieves:

- 1. If you are unsure of who the caller is DO NOT call it back, if it is important they will call vou back or leave a voicemail
- 2. Block the number most phones such as Iphone have the Facilities these days to block unwanted numbers so if you are unsure just block the call - better safe than sorry
- 3. Check out what is being said online a quick google search can easily prove what a number is and if this can be trusted or not
- 4. Unless you know who the caller is DO NOT CALL BACK! No matter how tempting it is, is it really worth the consequences?

I am aware that recently a few people are receiving spam texts also – did you know that if you get a spam message you can forward the message to 7726 (SPAM) and this will inform your network provider that this message is indeed a spam text, and it will (hopefully) stop you from getting further messages from that sender, however the more people who report the message the better - the networks can take action.



This summer, our continent will be captivated by the fifteenth edition of football's European Championships. This year, the tournament will be held in France for the third time, with twenty-four nations vying for the coveted trophy. Whether you're a diehard football fan or a relative newbie to sport, chances are high that you'll want to get involved with this fascinating competition. The hosts have a really exciting crop of young players and will be backed by incredible support, so they are definitely in with a great chance of winning. Furthermore, Belgium have assembled a remarkable squad in recent years; Germany appear formidable as holders of the World Cup; and England fans seem to be more optimistic of success than at almost any point in the past decade. Elsewhere, nations such as Portugal and Italy can never be written off at major tournaments, especially with individual players possessing the ability to win matches on their own. matches on their own.

THE UNDERDOGS

It's always fun to watch the best teams play, but we all love an underdog. Fortunately, there are plenty of nations at Euro 2016 with fun stories and interesting ambitions.

Wales have qualified for a major tournament for the first time in fifty-eight years and, in Gareth Bale, they possess one of the world's greatest players. Similarly, Northern Ireland will enjoy their first triumph in the 1966 World Cup. In fact, the Three Lions have never ventured beyond the semi-finals, so that will be a tantalising aim for Roy Hodgson and his men.

Germany have played in six Euro finals, a record by far. The next best total is Spain and the old Soviet Union with four, while Italy have reached that stage three times. In 2012, Spain thumped Italy 4-0 in the final before 63,170 in Kiev.

PREDICTION

I think Germany will live up to expectations and go close, with Portugal and England also real dark horses. However, you cannot look beyond France when attempting to pick a winner. Backed by a passionate home support, and boasting a squad of phenomenal quality, the hosts seem to tick every box. I think they'll dominate the tournament and lift the trophy in July.







From mowing the lawn to tackling pests, read this advice on how to keep your garden in tip top condition during the summer months.

Remember to water

Watering is essential as the weather warms up. Give your garden a big

drink once or twice a week to draw plant roots deeper into the nutritious soil. Containers and hanging baskets will need watering once a day – perhaps twice a day if it is hot and windy.

For larger shrubs and trees, leave a hose dribbling around the base for an hour. Your hedges can be watered with a home-made "trickle hose" — a length of old hose pierced with tiny holes.

It may officially be summer but the great British weather likes to keep us guessing. Keep vulnerable plants protected at night if frost is forecast. It is best to keep your tender plants indoors until the middle of the month.

Make time to mow

A buzzing lawn mower is the quintessential sound of summer – this is definitely the time for mowing. Little and often is better than a big attack every once in a while, so try to cut the grass once a week.

Ideally, spread your grass clippings across the compost heap in shallow layers. A huge mound might turn slimy and spoil the compost underneath.

If your lawn is newly laid, do not let the turf dry out in hot weather. Water it every evening and, if we do have a heat wave, consider letting the grass grow a little longer than usual to help it through the dry spell

Tackle pests

With a bit of luck, it will be nice and warm in the garden now. But you will not be the only one enjoying the weather, so keep an eye out for pests. Greenfly and blackfly in particular love the heat. If you catch caterpillar and aphid infestations early enough, they can be dealt with by hand. Aphids and other sap-sucking insects can transmit viruses.



Remember the birds

Do not wait for winter to feed the birds in your garden. If the hot weather continues and the ground hardens, it will be much more difficult for them to find food. Put some out to supplement their diet and help them build their reserves for winter. Birds love to splash about on hot summer days, so why not choose from a fantastic range of bird baths from £19.99.



Protect your produce

Home-grown fruit is delicious and fun to grow. Keep an especially watchful eye on it in dry weather — water regularly and keep picking. Mulching with organic matter will help reduce water loss and suppress weeds.

Try organic farmyard manure, 50L, £4.99.

If you grow vegetables under glass, remember that even greenhouses can get too hot. Keep them shaded on hot days, and spray the floor with water in the morning to create a humid atmosphere.

Do not do this at night, though, because the humidity and lower temperatures can encourage pests and disease. **Order online** for delivery!
