

Keeping you motoring

Suzuki Vitara S 1.4 Boosterjet



The so-called Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) or Crossover has been selling particularly well for a while now, thanks to buyers looking for a car that can tick all the boxes such as; space, practicability, economy and performance.

So, this week I have the rather good looking Suzuki Vitara S on test and I have to say, it's putting on a pretty good show in convincing me that maybe this is the one we really should all be looking at.

Power and Efficiency

The Vitara 'S' is powered by a four-cylinder direct injection turbocharged petrol engine that produces 140ps at 5500rpm and 220Nm of torque between 1500-4000rpm. 0 to 62 mph is dealt with in 10.2 seconds – moving onto a top speed of around 124 mph. The official fuel economy figures from Suzuki are; 52.3 mpg (combined) with a CO2 rating of 127 g/km - although the best I could get was around 44mpg, but then I was not really trying to get near what Suzuki had said was possible.

On the Road

I like the way the Vitara handles – but I do feel the suspension needs to be a little stiffer - saying that, when the road gets twisty – it is more than capable of holding it's own thanks to the ALLGRIP 4-wheel drive system which in real terms performs well. You also get a lot of information through the steering as to what the wheels are doing on the surface of the road - which all helps in giving you a lot of confidence into the corners. If you do decide to take the Vitara onto a muddy field - or a slippery surface – you can be assured it will do its best to move you along at a reasonable pace, whilst keeping you on the straight and narrow.

Safety and Technology

My test car was fitted with suede seating and red interior accents which lifts even the most boring of interiors – Not that the inside is boring, but you do sense the Vitara was set out to be more practical that luxurious.

Space – well let's just say it has bags of it – along with a decent driving position and plenty of room in the back for three adults - even people who are 6ft plus would have no problem fitting in. The boot is pretty good too with max luggage capacity coming in around 710 litres.

Some of the standard features on the Vitara S include; LED daytime running lights, LED projector headlamps, ALLGRIP 4-wheel drive system, adaptive cruise control, DAB digital radio with 6 speakers, USB, Bluetooth and iPod, driver and passenger front, side and curtain airbags, ABS with EBD, Electronic Stability Program, Hill Hold Control and Hill Descent, front & rear parking sensors and rear parking camera.

To Sum Up

Suzuki have done a fantastic job here - and I expect the Vitara S to sell well in what is now a fast paced SUV market.

Willaston WW1 Commemoration Weekend 9th-11th November 2018

Willaston will be commemorating the centenary of the end of the First World War with a programme of activities designed to remember those in our village who lost their lives and to celebrate those who returned and the end of hostilities.

At the end of October, silhouettes will appear in public places throughout the village to represent those that did not return, and a Commemorative Walk will be available describing Willaston in 1918 and telling the stories of some of those from our village who died during the war.

A series of events will take place over the weekend as follows:

Concert featuring Alex McMillan on the organ and the City of Chester Male Voice Choir – Friday 9th November at 7.30pm at Christ Church. YOUR GARDEN IN NOVEMBER

Autumn is coming, with its shorter and colder days. Winter is fast approaching. What should you do for your garden in autumn? Prepare it for the winter of course!

Plant, transplant, transplant

Autumn is the ideal season for transplanting trees and transplanting plants because the land is sufficiently wet due to regular rainfall. As the soil is still warm with the summer ending and the autumn starting, the plants still have time to adapt to a new place and to form new roots.

New plants can be transplanted in the fall without any worry. It's your last chance before winter to bring a touch of color to your garden. Autumn is the perfect season to plant roses, for example, before the first frosts.

Plant bulbs

You can also plant bulbs in autumn so that their flowers germinate with the arrival of spring and color your garden. Orientation is crucial for these spring heralds to bloom beautifully.

If the soil is cool and wet in the spring, it may be dry and porous in the summer, during their dormancy period. The bulbs should be planted in the ground at a depth of about two to three times their size.



Cut herbaceous perennials, shrubs and bushes

When shrubs turn yellow, their stems bend to the ground or begin to wither, it is time to cut them. Indeed, plants begin to bring sap back to their own roots. If they are not cut, they may be wasted.

Shrubs and bushes can be cut to about a quarter of their size. This varies, however, depending on the type of shrub or bush. You can find more information on plant tags or by inquiring at your local garden centre.

Trim the hedges

Hedgerows should be cut one last time in the fall to prevent rotting with moisture accumulation.

Cut evergreen hedges as much as possible, being careful not to form holes, otherwise they will not grow back in the winter and they will look bare.

Also clear the hedges of fallen tree leaves, otherwise they will not breathe well, will not absorb daylight and may rot.

Maintain the lawn



In winter, rain, cold and lack of sunshine degrade the lawn. That's why she needs to be pampered before the cold weather arrives. When leaves fall in autumn, they should be regularly raked from the lawn. If you leave them, the lawn will lack light, which will encourage the formation of dry brown plots and also moss.

Mow your lawn for the last time in early November. Be careful not to mow it at a height of less than 5 cm as a longer grass absorbs a small amount of light better. It will be more resistant to weeds and frothing.

The use of an autumn fertilizer is also recommended. Autumn fertilizers usually contain little nitrogen and a lot of potassium. This amount of potassium helps strengthen the turf and improve its resistance to freezing. In the fall, avoid using traditional lawn fertilizers because their high nitrogen content is such that the grass grows faster, which increases the sensitivity of the grass to frost.

Naturally, here are some other small things to remember to anticipate the first frosts:

- Flower beds, roses and other non-frost resistant plants should be covered with twigs, leaves or wrapped in bubble wrap or similar material.
- Clean summer bulbs like dahlias and keep them in a well ventilated cardboard in your cellar.
- Take the potted plants indoors or place them in the shelter.
- Disconnect incoming water and empty faucets and sprinklers to prevent frost damage.
- Remove the pumps from the tanks and, if necessary, install an anti-freeze pump.

With the arrival of winter, we can rest gardening tasks. But beware, it will soon be time to recover!



'Down and dirty' volunteers 'scrubbed-up nicely' with the help of local personal trainer.



A group of staff and volunteers from Cheshire Autism Practical Support (ChAPS) got 'down and dirty' to complete the Tough Mudder North West and raise over $\pounds 2,000$ for the charity.

Team leader Tom Makin-Bell and local fitness ace and personal trainer James Nickson from Frodsham's very own Turnup Training, put together a team of ten people to take on the event which consists of a ten-mile run along with 22 military assault course obstacles – and plenty of mud! The challenge took place at Cholmondeley Castle near Malpas, raising funds for the ChAPS charity which helps people on the autism spectrum across Cheshire.

Tom Makin-Bell said: "Most of the people on this team are from families with autism or are supporters of our charity so for us to get ten people to turn up on the day is a massive achievement.

"For those people to then go on and help each other around this challenging course is a huge deal considering that most of them hadn't met when we started training six months ago."

The team were trained by James, who runs the Turnup Training fitness studio five minutes from the town centre. He said: "When I met this bunch for the first time, I didn't know any of them and they were all of different ages, abilities and fitness levels plus I'd never done a Tough Mudder before myself.

"So we concentrated on developing core fitness and communication to enable them to more easily help each other around.

"Although on the day we were there to get 'down and dirty', I think they all scrubbed up really well!" Tom and James were joined in the team by Jenn Whiting, Chris Peters, Rachael Butler, Darrell Lockett, Luke Peel, John Forest, Daniel Batterton and Chris O'Connor. Suzanne Robinson and Barry Quinn also completed all the training but unfortunately had to pull out at the last minute due to injury.

And a smaller team from ChAPS is now set for another event – 'Hellrunner', a 'Hell Up North' event taking place in Delamere Forest in Cheshire on October 13th. This event is a full-length half marathon with multiple landscape obstacles and huge amounts of mud.





CAMRA WIRRAL PUB TRAIL

BEBINGTON VILLAGE - HIGHER BEBINGTON - BRIMSTAGE -Thornton Hough - Raby, 4 historic pubs 5.6 miles along roads and country footpaths





Start at the *Rose & Crown* in Bebington Village (bus routes 410, 487/8, 464). This former coaching inn was built in 1732 and is now a thriving suburban pub serving up to four Thwaites beers. Cross the road outside the pub and walk down to the roundabout to the right and

turn left up Heath Road. Follow the road passing Wirral Grammar schools on your left and continue along the main road onto Teehey Lane. When you reach a row of shops on your right, turn left up Village Road immediately before The Acorn pub.

As you walk up Village Road you pass Victoria Hall on your right. This village hall, described as an architectural gem, was built in 1897 from Storeton stone quarried a few hundred yards away and was the venue for a Beatles concert in August 1962. Further on



your right is Royal Oak Chambers, originally a pub which was closed in the late 1950s and replaced by the nearby Acorn. Continue up Village Road passing the George on the left

until you reach the **Travellers Rest** at the top of the road. Reputedly over 300 years old, this cosy pub is decorated throughout with brasses and bric-a-brac. The beers are mainly well known brands with a guest ale often from local micro-breweries. At lunchtime the emphasis is on food (no food Sun), but in the evening this is very much a traditional pub.

Cross the main Mount Road. Walk down Rest Hill Road for 100 yards and as you reach the end of the woods turn left onto the footpath and follow this along the edge of the woods. When you reach a gate to private property, take the public footpath on the right and follow this until it emerges on Red Hill Road. Turn right and in front of you, slightly to the left, cross a stile and follow the public footpath across a field, a wooden bridge and then two more fields until you reach Brimstage Lane.

Follow the road ahead, going under the motorway, cross an avenue of trees with a World War 2 pillbox on the right and as you enter Brimstage village you pass farm buildings on your left where Brimstage Brewery is located. Cross the main road and turn right and after a few yards turn left to Brimstage Hall Courtyard. Turn right in front of the buildings, cross the car park and the stile immediately opposite then cross the field and back onto the main road.

Follow the footpath straight on turning left into Talbot Avenue and then after 10 yards left again onto a signposted footpath. After a few hundred yards where the main track turns left, take the narrow footpath straight on along the left hand side of one field and across the centre of the next onto a tree lined private avenue which leads to Thornton Manor. Cross the avenue and follow the public footpath across further fields until you reach a second tree lined avenue (Grange Drive) where you turn right and then after a few yards, turn left up the made up track eventually reaching farm gates. Pass to the right of the gates and carry on past the farm buildings until you reach the main road in Thornton Hough, Lever's model village for its executive workers.

Turn right you will see the *Seven Stars*, built in the 1850s, a focal point for locals, walkers and cyclists.

The pub has a comfortable single bar and lounge area with the emphasis meals on and three rotating guest often beers from local breweries.



Turn right out of the pub and right again down Church Road, passing the church on your right before turning left onto Raby Road. Follow the road to Raby where you will see the **Wheatsheaf** across the green. **The** '**Thatch**' was rebuilt following a fire in 1611

and has been a pub for 350 years, Wirral's oldest pub. The walls are decorated with old photographs of Raby. The bar has nine hand pumps with four guest beers including locally brewed Brimstage Trappers Hat. Food is served in the bar until 5pm.



Buses (route 84/85) run hourly to Heswall, Spital and Bromborough but in the evening or Sunday you will need to retrace your walk to Thornton Hough for the 487/8 bus between Neston and Birkenhead.

Last year Teams4U distributed 38,000 gift-filled shoeboxes to Belarus, Bosnia, the Ukraine and Romania. The Teams4U charity also works throughout the year with the local people in these countries to help improve the quality of their lives. From 2018 Teams4U will be operating on the Wirral with their own warehouse collecting shoeboxes for children.

Dave Cooke, the founder of the original Christmas Shoebox Charity has never been a stranger to risks or the dedication it takes to start up a charity! In 1990, after seeing the images break of the orphans from Ceausescu's regime in Romania, he decided, with the help of some friends, to get an aid wagon together and drive it across Europe, hoping the medical supplies, beds, blankets and clothes would radically change the horrific conditions in which these children were living. What he didn't know (and no-one knew) was that the few thousand shoebox gifts that went across with the convoy from Wrexham would grow into the biggest shoebox programme in the world!

In 1994 Operation Christmas Child was amalgamated with the American-led International Charity Samaritan's Purse. Dave resigned from his job as Contracts Manager for a Window Installation company and became SP's Overseas Projects Manager, delivering shoeboxes all across the world whilst developing their Soccer programme and Second Chance programme; taking sports and games to streetchildren and juvenile convicts.

From those years pioneering new programmes and visiting new countries grew the seeds for Teams4U. Seeing children without family or community, traumatised through abuse, war and poverty, laugh and play again through the sports programmes empowered Dave to make that the focus of T4U. Dave founded Teams4U in 2006 after experiencing the atrocities of the Beslan crisis in 2004 when over 300 people were killed in a school attack in Russia. From his experience working as an International Projects Manager for SP, he was invited to take a team of volunteers into Beslan to be part of the rehabilitation process there. Out of that harrowing situation, Dave realised the difference short-term teams can make and wanted to set up an organisation that could give anyone the opportunity of travelling abroad to assist children in crisis.

"I want to give people who aren't able to give up their day-to-day lives the opportunity to go overseas and make a difference. Most of us have jobs, families, mortgages and bills to pay. We can't all spend months or years abroad. But I don't want that to stop people from travelling to the third world, getting off the tourist route, and meeting the needs of the children there. From whatever walk or stage of life you're in, I want to give you the opportunity to travel with Teams4U " Dave Cooke

Meanwhile, if you don't fancy volunteering abroad the Charity has returned to the simple model of giving a shoebox for a boy, a girl or a family box at Christmastime.
