Homeshare helps people stay in their own home

Things could have been very different for Shirley (85), when she was diagnosed with dementia. With her family living abroad, it looked like she might have to follow the route of many older people and go into a home.

Yet thanks to an innovative new scheme called **PossAbilities Homeshare**, Shirley offered a vacant room in her home in return for a few hours a week of help around the house and company.

Haylea, a volunteer with Princes Trust, heard about the scheme and was soon matched with Shirley. She said "It's great here, I do a bit of cleaning and put the bins out for Shirley. We like to have tea and make cakes, and then I have my own life too. I live in a great place that I wouldn't normally be able to afford".

Shirley's daughter Brenda praised the scheme "It's not easy when your relative is diagnosed with dementia. It's even harder when you live far away like I do. Homeshare is ideal for older people

whether or not they have dementia".

Heather Nielsen, of social enterprise **PossAbilities Homeshare**, said "We are delighted to be working with **Wirral Health & Care** to promote Homeshare across Wirral. We're looking forward to bringing more people together to make lives easier and tackle loneliness".



AUTOREVIEW by **Tony Yates** Keeping you motoring

SEAT Arona SE Technology Lux 1.6 TDI 115PS 6-speed manual



This month's road test puts me into a car that many of you probably don't even realise exists! This is a car that sits very quietly in the shadows of many other cars on the road, and I doubt that some of you have ever seen it on the road yet. Well the reason for this is that while most of you will go with what's currently in fashion, and what's hip, there are some of you out there like me that need a car to do exactly what it says on the tin - and the new Seat Arona is exactly that sort of car - so get vour head down and read on.

Power and Efficiency:

The Arona I currently have on test is powered by a115PS, 1.6 TDI - four-cylinder diesel engine with a 6-speed manual gearbox and a respectable top speed of around115mph, plus a 0-62 time of 10.3 seconds. Fuel consumption is also very good with a combined figure of 65.7 mpg.

On the road:

I like the way the Arona handles – it feels very well balanced. Also, when the road gets twisty it's more than capable of holding its own. The steering also feels light and agile – and when you hook all this up to its fantastic 6-speed gearbox – you really can't go wrong, and It's no exaggeration for me to say that I think the Arona is the better car here when you compare it to some of its rivals.

Interior & Technology

As with all Seat's, the interior is of a good standard – but, as I have said many times, Seat is a part of VW group, so it will last for years. The seating is actually rather good even after a long journey, and the dials and switches are laid out very well and are very clear and precise.

Some of the standard equipment across the range includes; Bi-colour roof, Halogen front headlights, Front fog lights with cornering, Function, LED Daytime Running Lights (DRLs), LED taillights, Rear fog lights, Black roof rails, Body-coloured door handles, Electrically adjustable door mirrors, FM/AM radio, DAB (digital audio broadcasting) Six speakers, Bluetooth, Colour: 6.5" colour touchscreen + USB port + Aux-in, Dimming interior rear view mirror, Interior ambient lighting, Interior Chrome Pack, Air conditioning, Electric front and rear windows, Cruise control, Auto-headlights, Comfort suspension, Driver and front passenger airbags, Front side and curtain airbags, Active front head restraints, Anti-lock brake system (ABS), Electronic Stability Control (ESC) with Emergency Brake Assist (EBA) and Hill hold control.

Plus it doesn't stop there either – as this is the SE Technology Lux version, you also get additional features such as; Beats Audio: 300w subwoofer, 18" spacesaving spare wheel, Luggage compartment lining, Heated front seats, Heated washer nozzles, Adaptive Cruise Control and KESSY (Keyless Entry and Go)

To sum up:

I'm going to give the Arona five stars in this test (which is rare for me), not only because I like it a lot - but because I believe it's worth every penny. Next time you are out looking for a new compact SUV, try looking that little bit harder because as I have shown here today, the Arona is a brilliant buy.

Cheshire Wildlife Trust given £143,000 to help local volunteers make a real difference in their community

Cheshire Wildlife Trust has been given £143,000 National Lottery funding from Sport England to help local volunteers make a positive contribution to their community using sport and activity. The project, Go Wild – Get Fit, will improve physical activity levels of more than 200 people currently furthest away from the job market and living in Chester, Ellesmere Port, Northwich and Winsford. Volunteers will have opportunity to take part in a range of nature-based activities during the programme including, practical conservation, wildlife surveying and monitoring and nature walks. The programme also offers opportunities for training in wildlife skills and broader life skills.

Go Wild – Get Fit is funded through Sport England's 'Opportunity Fund', which aims to encourage people to volunteer to help tackle challenges their communities face. Projects are being funded in areas that may experience economic disadvantage, ranging from inner-city areas with high levels of crime and social exclusion, to remote rural areas with few services. "Volunteering can do wonders for job and career prospects, mental health and making friends. it's why volunteering sits at the heart of Sport England's new strategy, towards an active nation. What to do in the Garden in January

In frosty weather little can be done in the garden. The ground is too hard to dig or plant and the lawn should not be walked

English Countryside Winter Scene

Despite the low temperatures and short daylight hours, there some useful tasks that can be done. If the weather is mild, you can still plant roses and bare rooted shrubs and trees. At this is time of year a heated greenhouse has great appeal, especially when the weather is too cold and wet to work outside. The warmth of a heated cold-frame or greenhouse or even a sunny indoor window enables you to sow annuals that need a long growing season and start of those early vegetable crops. Roots of favourite herbs, can also be lifted and brought indoors, to provide fresh shoots and leaves for winter flavour.



Winter digging is necessary for beds and borders that need to be planted in early spring. The earlier this is done the better, allowing time for frosts to act and break down the soil. The longer any rough clods of soil are exposed to frost, the easier it will be to get a fine tilth in spring. While digging, it is a good idea to work in plenty of well-rotted manure or garden compost at the same time, thus improving the soil's texture and richness.



on. Although there is very little work to do, January ushers in the beginning of a new year that is full of promise in the garden.

If you have planted any trees or shrubs during the winter months, check that they haven't been lifted by frost. Once lifted, they can rock in the wind and their roots will be slower to get established. Re-firm the plants by pressing down on the surrounding soil with your feet. You may also need to stake any tall or exposed plants to prevent further wind rock.

If the surface of water features or a pond has frozen solid, and particularly if it contains fish, break the ice with care. If the ice is very thick, use a little boiling water rather than a hammer, to avoid shock waves which can kill the creatures beneath.

Planning Next Seasons Garden

The long winter evenings provide plenty of time to browse through seed catalogues and plan new projects in the garden. Late January to early February is an ideal time to visit garden centres to buy seeds, tubers and bulbs for the coming season. If you are ordering products from a seed catalogue, or over the internet, it should be done as early as possible or they may arrive too late for their proper sowing or planting dates.



Maintain and Check Garden Tools and Equipment

Make sure that mechanical equipment such as mowers, rotovators, edgers, strimmers and hedge trimmers are in good working order. If any need repairing or sharpening, take them in for servicing by a professional.



CAMRA WIRRAL PUB TRAIL

HOOTON — LITTLE NESTON - PARKGATE, 5/6 PUBS. 7½ Miles Mainly on Country Footpaths .



Start at Hooton Station and the adjacent **Hooton Hotel**. Originally a small hotel it is now a family-friendly pub-restaurant with garden area and three changing cask beers. Turn left along the main road and just after the top of the bridge over the railway, turn left down the marked footpath along the Wirral Way. This follows the tracks of the old Hooton to West Kirby railway line which was closed in 1962.



In less than a mile you pass under a road bridge and after a few hundred more yards, where a fence forms a barrier partially blocking the track, turn off to the right and follow a narrow path which runs parallel to

the Wirral Way. After a few hundred yards this opens up to a wide track, Smithy Lane, which you follow into Willaston. When you reach Hadlow Road turn right and go to the end of the road where opposite you will see, the **Nags Head**. Extensively Refurbished in 2011, this pub combines good food and good beer in warm relaxing surroundings. We serve a range of Real Ale and Guest Bitters. **See our advert on page 46**.



Return along Hadlow Road but continue until you reach Hadlow Road Station, preserved following closure to passengers in 1956. Turn right along the Wirral Way and continue under three road bridges, following the marked footpath. Less than half a mile after the last bridge (the A540 Chester High

Road) you cross a footbridge over a track and immediately turn left down steps and over a stile at the bottom. Turn right and follow the track straight ahead which narrows to a footpath. After less than half a mile turn right following the main pathway. You will eventually emerge on Gorstons Lane where you turn left, keeping the houses on your right. At the end of the road turn right following the road and keeping the school on your left hand side. Follow Woodfall Lane downhill, at the main road turn right then follow the road (Bull Hill) to the left continuing downhill until you reach a roundabout. Cross the roundabout and continue down Bull Hill then Marshlands Lane until you reach the Dee Marshes.

Turn left and after two hundred yards you arrive at the **Harp** Inn. The pub is a former coal miners' inn near to the site of Neston Colliery which closed in 1927. Converted from two cottages, it has a public bar with real fire in winter and a drinking area at the front overlooking the marshes. The beer range includes Landlord, Holt Bitter, Peerless Triple Blonde plus two quest beers.

Turn right out of the pub and go straight on passing the bottom of Marshlands Lane




and follow the track ahead keeping the Marshes on your left. The track becomes a footpath, then over a stile and into open ground crossing three wooden foot bridges before becoming a footpath on the edge of the marshes. Follow the footpath which can be boggy or overgrown at times until you reach a track where you have to turn right away from the marshes. When you reach the road turn left onto Manorial Road South and continue straight ahead eventually onto Manorial Road. At the end of the road take the footpath on the left and this brings you back to the marshes and onto the Parade at Parkgate.

300 yards on the right is the **Ship Hotel**. The hotel dates from 1787 when it was known as the Princess Royal after a

locally-built ship. The hotel bar serves food all day and features historic photos of old Parkgate. Beers include Brimstage Trappers Hat plus three guests.

Another 200 yards along the Parade is the Red Lion. This is an excellent multi-roomed traditional inn and the oldest unchanged pub in Parkgate, dating from 1822. One



Turn right out of the **Red Lion**, 100 yards to the square to catch a bus home. Routes X22 and 22 (not Sunday) Heswall

to Chester, 487 (evenings and Sunday) to Liverpool via Bebington and Birkenhead. Or if you have time before the bus arrives, continue along the Parade to the Boat House where the bar serves up to six changing beers, including its own house beers from Conwy Brewery.





Prep time: **20 minutes** Total time: **5 hours, 45 minutes** (inc. refrigerating) Makes: **16 servings**

- 1 1/2 cups digestive biscuit crumbs 3 tablespoons sugar
 - 1/3 cup butter or margarine, melted
 - 4 packages (8 ounces each) PHILADELPHIA Cream Cheese, softened
 - 1 cup sugar
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
 - 4 eggs
 - 1 cup canned cherries



MIX digestive crumbs, 3 tablespoons sugar and butter; press onto bottom of 9-inch springform pan.

BEAT cream cheese, 1 cup sugar and vanilla with mixer until blended. Add eggs, 1 at a time, mixing on low speed after each just until blended. Pour over crust.

BAKE 1 hour or until centre is almost set. Run knife around rim of pan to loosen cake; cool before removing rim. Refrigerate cheesecake 4 hours. Top with canned cherries, if desired.






