

🔤 Celebrating 40 years of counting garden birds in Cheshire



RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch is 40!

- Over 8 million hours have been spent watching garden birds since the Birdwatch began in 1979 with more than 130 million birds counted.
- To mark the event, the RSPB is asking participants in Cheshire 'How will you #BigGardenBirdWatch?' and to share their stories of how they take part.

The RSPB is eagerly anticipating who will be top of the pecking order for a very special anniversary of its' world famous Big Garden Birdwatch in January.

Just one hour every year, for the last 40 years, has made the RSPB's Big Garden Birdwatch the largest garden wildlife citizen science project. During that time, hundreds of thousands of people, including those across Cheshire, have volunteered their time providing the RSPB with over 8 million hours of monitoring garden birds.

To mark the event, the RSPB is encouraging participants in the county to share their Big Garden Birdwatch stories on social media. 'How will you #BigGardenBirdWatch?' will showcase some of the best examples of how people take part, from building their own birdwatching den, baking birdseed cakes and dressing up as Batman to see Robin.

This year's Big Garden Birdwatch takes place on 26, 27 and 28 January 2019. The public is asked to spend just one hour watching and recording the birds in their garden or local green space, then send their results to the RSPB. Close to half-a-million people join in the Birdwatch every year, with 9700 people across Cheshire taking part in 2018.

To help prepare for Big Garden Birdwatch 2019, there are events on offer across Cheshire this January - from discovering how to attract more wildlife into your garden to gaining tips on how to identify the creatures that live on vour doorsten:

'Get Ready for the Big Garden Birdwatch' will be held at RSPB Burton Mere Wetlands nature reserve near Neston on Sunday 20 January. Drop-in from 1-3pm to make bird feeders, and the knowledgeable team will also be on hand to assist with garden bird identification to help you prepare for the birdwatch. Cost £2 per feeder, normal entry fees apply to non-members visiting the reserve (RSPB members free), no booking needed.

A 'Big Garden Birdwatch quiz trail' will also be taking place at Burton Mere Wetlands throughout the month, Families are encouraged to take part in this self-led activity to discover more about garden birds and how to take part in the Birdwatch. Cost £1 per quiz sheet, normal entry fees apply to nonmembers visiting the reserve (RSPB members free), no booking needed. More details for both can be found at rspb.org.uk/burtonmerewetlands

Over the last 40 years, 130 million birds have been counted giving the RSPB an astonishing amount of insight into how our wildlife is faring.

For four decades, Big Garden Birdwatch has highlighted the winners and losers in the garden bird world. It was first to alert the RSPB to the decline in song thrush numbers. The song thrush was a firm fixture in the top 10 in 1979. By 2009, its numbers were less than half those recorded in 1979, plummeting to 20th in the rankings.

"Reaching 40 years is a huge achievement and shows just how passionate people across the UK are about their wildlife. The survey started as a winter activity for our youth members. It's now the largest garden wildlife survey in the world and appeals to both children and adults because it's an enjoyable. easy, inclusive activity that anyone can do, and a great opportunity to connect with nature."



From Playa del Carmen you can take the ferry to Cozumel.

Once in Cozumel, there are lots of places within walking-distance, or you can take a cab, rent a car, or even a scooter.

Keeping you motoring

Subaru BRZ 2.0i SE Lux



Dynamic, sophisticated and thrilling, that's what I think of the new updated BRZ.

With its low centre of gravity, rearwheel drive and taut chassis all helping it deliver exceptional onroad handling. This is what being a motoring journalist is all about - and why I love the BRZ so much. So, what's new for 2018. Well, the BRZ now boasts an upgraded infotainment system, with 7" multi-function display. satellite navigation, DAB radio and Apple CarPlay™ and Android Auto™ all as standard.

Power and Efficiency:

Fitted with a 2.0-litre horizontally-opposed (Boxer). four-cylinder, four-stroke (DOHC 16V) petrol engine with 200PS @ 7000rpm and 205Nm of torque. 0-62mph is around 7.6sec, fuel consumption is a decent 32.8 mpg combined and a top speed of around 140mph.

For all those tech nerds, out there - the engine's pistons are placed 180 degrees apart allowing a lower, flatter engine profile. This gives the powerplant - and therefore the whole car- a lower centre of gravity. This more balanced weight distribution gives the BRZ exceptional handling, poise and more importantly control.

Boxer engines have taken some stick in the past, but, they fascinate me and the Boxer engine in the BRZ is pretty cool, thanks to key features such as the engine's square bore and stroke (86mm x 86mm), which all helps achieve a balance between mechanical efficiency, environmental performance, speed and power.

The engine is also fitted with an intelligent port injection system, which selects the appropriate fuel injection rate to provide greater fuel efficiency and lower emissions - all wonderful stuff then!

On the road:

Nimble, frisky and if I am being honest, a little minx – and that's just to get you started. Take the nimble little BRZ out on the road and you will feel how well it grips as I said early on in this review. Again, all thanks to the BRZ being fitted with a Torsen limited-slip rear differential for improved traction, allowing the more enthusiastic driver to make the most of the car's rear-wheel-drive layout.

Also, using a rear-wheel-drive sports car drivetrain allows the engine to sit further back in the BRZ chassis, which helps provide a perfect balance for precise control and grip during high-speed cornering. The BRZ is also fitted with a quick-ratio steering system — tuned to react instantly to every input, which makes it feel like a proper racer.

Of course, to get the best out of a sports car you need to have a front-engined, rear-wheel drive layout – and the BRZ has this by the bucket load.


For 2018, there have been some changes, and although very small – they all make a big difference. Sometimes when you have the perfect balance between man and machine, it's not worth trying to perfect it more when you got it right first time around.

Design and Technology:

Some of the additional standard equipment on the BRZ includes; Subaru Boxer engine (2.0 litre petrol), Rear-Wheel Drive, Track Mode function, Torsen® Limited Slip Differential, LED headlights, Keyless Entry & Push Button Start System, 7" multi-function colour touchscreen with Apple CarPlay™ and Android Auto™ and Satellite navigation.

To sum up: What can I say – the BRZ is a great drive and perfect for someone who wants a nimble little sports car.



What to do in the garden in February

Everyone knows gardening is seasonal, but the variations in our weather, and range across the UK means the rules about what to do when in the garden are not hard and fast rules. Gardening advice has to be moderated by the weather . No two Springs are ever the same and the weather can make a big difference.

February is a pruning month, although it is always best done in a mild spell. What to do in the garden in February depends where in the country you are gardening. If you garden in the south of England or have a garden which is sheltered, more can be done earlier, but northern gardeners, especially those with exposed plots, may need to leave tasks to late February or Early March. All gardening calendars are just a guide it depends on the weather.

Pruning in February

February is pruning month for two tricky climbers: Clematis and Wisteria.

Getting Wisteria to flower is more reliable if it is pruned correctly. How to make Wisteria flower is one of the most frequently asked questions.

Before pruning a clematis, it is first necessary to work out to which pruning group the Clematis belongs and then check out how to prune it.

If it's characterised by large flowers in the mid summer, it needs only a light prune. If it flowers bloom from mid to late summer, it's a harder prune. The words "pruning" and "Clematis" are scary but here is how to make it easy. Do not prune the early flowering Clematis at all, which are those which flower between February and May, they are varieties such as Clematis Montana, Alpina, Armandii.



These types of Clematis, because they flower shortly after this time of the year which is early in the growing year, if you were to prune now you would cut off the branches carrying the flower buds. They only need pruning if they get out of control. These images left show the axil buds which you need to identify whether you are pruning either group.

What to sow in February

To germinate seeds early in the year a warm, benign environment is needed. Very few gardeners can afford the luxury of a heated greenhouse which means bringing seed trays into the house, not ideal, or using a heated propagator mat and site the seed trays in a porch or unheated conservatory. Seeds will need to be placed into a sealed propagator to create a warm atmosphere which will not dry out, and once germinated, removed and kept frost free. Light levels are very low in February so seeding is not easy and plants need to be turned regularly to keep even growth.

The benefits of seeding in February is if it goes well, the plants will mature earlier. Sowing in March and April is easier because of the extra light and warmth.

Suitable for seeding in February: Aubergines, Beetroot, chilies, courgettes and cucumbers, french beans, lettuce and rocket and tomatoes. Flower seeds, many of the popular garden plants such as Ageratum, Antirrhinum, Calendula, Cornflower, French Marigolds, Nigella, Rudbeckia, Salvia, Scabious and Zinnia.

Sow half-hardy annuals



Duke and Duchess of Sussex open citizens' supermarket at Pyramids Shopping Centre on 14th January 2019



The Pyramids Shopping Centre welcomed the arrival of Their Royal Highnesses, The Duke and Duchess of Sussex who officially opened the Number 7 subsidised café and supermarket, which has been set up in partnership with local MP Frank Field's charitable organisation, Feeding Birkenhead.

As part of their first visit to Merseyside as a couple, Prince Harry and Meghan were at Pyramids from 11.40am until 12.20pm to meet with the shopping centre's director, Derek Millar, Frank Field and the team at Number 7.

The collaboration between Pyramids and Feeding Birkenhead to bring a membership-based, non-profit food shop and café to help local people at risk of hunger has been five years in the making. The initiative is part of the wider Feeding Britain network, which aims to eliminate hunger in the UK.

Birkenhead-based shipbuilder, Cammell Laird began refurbishing the 903m sq. unit at 7 Princes Pavement completely free of charge in spring 2018. The café opened its doors in November and has been extremely well received by the community. The supermarket completed just before Christmas and has been enjoying a successful few weeks.

"Working with Frank Field on this pioneering service is one of the most important projects I've been involved with in my career," said Derek Millar, Centre Director at Pyramids Shopping Centre. "What Feeding Birkenhead, Cammell Laird, Pyramids and all the other stakeholders and individuals have contributed in terms of time, funding, supplies, support – the list goes on - is something we are all immensely proud of.

"We are honoured to have had this phenomenal opportunity to welcome the Duke and Duchess of Sussex to Pyramids Shopping Centre and to share our story with them is truly amazing," said Derek. Number 7 focuses on the provision of good quality surplus food for people in Birkenhead who have difficulty paying the bills. Membership for the citizens' supermarket will be by referral from one of Feeding Birkenhead's partners, such as housing and healthcare organisations and are for six months initially, with the option to extend if further support is needed. Access to the café and community support services are available to all.

Prince Harry and Meghan were at Pyramids Shopping Centre for the official opening of its subsidised café and supermarket, Number 7.

Suppliers including Kellogg's and Brake have been keeping the shelves stocked. Additional services will see local charities and community groups providing a range of supportive services including welfare rights, debt advice, help looking for work, as well as budgeting support and cooking workshops.





Maggie's Merseyside at Clatterbridge, the cancer charity which provides free practical, emotional and social support for people living with cancer is opening up their Men's Cancer Support group to more visitors and men affected by cancer.

Located next to Clatterbridge Cancer Centre Maggie's is a warm and welcoming place, with qualified professionals on hand to offer an evidence-based core programme of support that has been shown to improve physical and emotional wellbeing.

The Men's Cancer support group facilitated by a phycologist is an opportunity for men to talk to other who been diagnosed with cancer. But they quickly found something and biopsies were taken. I was later diagnosed with Prostate Cancer. It came as a total shock as I felt fit and well. My daughter in-law is a cancer specialist and she accompanied me to appointments for moral support. I soon became in such a state and rather stressed that she recognised I needed further support, therefore she introduced me Maggie's. I initially just dropped in and I was surprised at the readily available support. I then began attending the Men's Cancer Support Group which opened up a whole new world of friendship and welcomed support which I didn't know existed. It became like a social club for me.

The group helped to remove my anxiety that came with the diagnosis and what's really special is that I no longer feel like I have cancer when I come to Maggie's and I look forward to coming. I have now gone on to join the walking group at Maggie's and have also benefited from their 'Living Prostate Cancer Course' which has helped with nutrition, exercise and

to develop coping mechanisms. I will continue to visit Maggie's as they've been so good and I enjoy meeting and talking to people who understand what I'm going through and to share experiences. Maggie's is just a lovely place to be when you require advice, support and friendship.'

Gemma Hollinaton. Psychologist at Mersevside expressed 'The group aims to provide a safe supportive safe for men to talk about their thoughts and feelings regarding life following a cancer diagnosis, and the challenges involved in managing different treatments. The group is open to men of all ages, and with any type of cancer. One of the key aims is to normalise the experience of difficult thoughts and feelings, alongside strengths and achievements. By sharing their experiences and ways of coping, men are able to support each other through the process of adjustment. There can also be a lot of laughter and light-heartedness, and previous group members have reported looking forward to the group and the social support it provides. Therefore we are welcoming more men to join the group and seek the support we offer? Maggie's Merseyside relies solely on the support and generosity of people and voluntary donations, you can help us to make sure that Maggie's support is available to everyone who needs it across Wirral, Merseyside, Cheshire and North Wales this year, next year and in the years to come.







A Wirral care home has been awarded the Golden Hearts in the Community award by YMCA Wirral for only the 25th time since the youth charity introduced the accolade 73 years ago.

The Hazelwell, a residential, nursing, palliative and respite care home in Heswall, which opened in the summer of 2016, has supported the organisation for the past two years. It has helped provide the YMCA Wirral with much-needed clothing parcels, such as hats, scarfs, gloves and other items to help people, without a home or shelter, deal with the cold temperatures in winter.

The care home has regularly raised money for the charity, including recently hosting a Christmas family day for residents and their families, staff and members of the community, with proceeds from a festive raffle donated to the YMCA Wirral night shelter at Birkenhead.

The YMCA Wirral was founded in 1874 and its mission is focused on helping young people to overcome homelessness and making sure that they feel like they belong and thrive in their local communities. The charity introduced the Golden Hearts in the Community award in 1946. Its first recipients were the Air Raid Patrol (ARP) who rescued residents from bombed-out houses -

who were subsequently left homeless - during the blitz in the Second World War around Royal Albert Dock.

The Hazelwell becomes the 25th receiver of the Golden Hearts in the Community award which is decided by an independent panel.

The organisation's chief executive Nigel Hughes said: "The Golden Hearts in the Community award is recognition that the staff and residents at The Hazelwell are a very special group of people in the Wirral community. It is not something which is awarded very often and only for an outstanding deed or gesture so it really is well-deserved.

"No other care home in the Wirral has ever helped the YMCA Wirral. The Hazelwell contacted us not long after it opened and have supported us ever since. The staff and residents are fully behind doing all they can for us. You would think that when a person goes into residential care that they would be more concerned about their own lives so it's extremely heart-warming for residents of The Hazelwell to think about trying to help others."

The Hazelwell care home manager Kathryn McGuinness said: "It's a huge honour for us to be given this award by the YMCA for only the 25th time in its long history.

"We are extremely pleased to have been able to support the YMCA Wirral in any way that we can. They are a fantastic charity who do fantastic work in our local community, which our residents recognise and are appreciative of.

"I'm sure that our residents and staff will continue to support the YMCA Wirral in achieving their mission. We look forward to working with Nigel and the charity for years to come."
