

Tenants will be given more rights when changes to the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 are made on 20 March 2019. People who rent will be able to sue their landlords if their homes are not up to scratch. Issues with damp, noise, ventilation, repairs, drainage, infestations and facilities for cooking are a number of the issue's tenants will be able to take action on. It will cover tenants immediately and not just for new tenancies, existing tenancies will be covered. These changes mean that those in social housing will now have more power to force local authorities to carry out necessary repairs.

It is estimated that over 1 million rented homes have hazards that pose a serious risk. The new changes will mean that tenants will be able to take their landlord to court for an injunction to compel the landlord to carry out the works or for damages (compensation) for the landlord's failure to keep the property in good repair.

Compensation can also be paid to tenants for any issues that have caused injury or illness.

On this holiday you will visit some amazing cities including Barcelona, which is the capital city of the autonomous community of Catalonia in Spain and Spain's second most populated city. Founded as a Roman city, in the Middle Ages Barcelona became the capital of the County of Barcelona.

Monuments and museums such as the Vatican Museums and the Colosseum are among the world's most visited tourist destinations with both locations receiving millions of tourists a year. Rome also hosted the 1960 Summer Olympics.

Rome has earned its ancient nickname of The Eternal City - no matter how many places in Italy vie for our attention, there's no city that can compare to Rome. Here you can walk the same streets that Caesar once walked, set foot in the smallest independent nation on earth, and see the handiwork of some of the world's greatest artists. Then you can turn a corner to see how modern Romans live alongside all that historic splendor.

Stroll through the one-time epicenter of the Roman Empire, gaze over the largest Roman amphitheater, see the Pope give his weekly address in St. Peter's Square, test your resolve at the Mouth of Truth, learn to fight like a gladiator, and find out what makes Roman pizza different from the stuff you'll eat in Naples. Few cities can entertain and overwhelm as quickly as Rome, so plan to take your time - and take plenty of breaks to sample the city's famous coffee and gelato. And don't forget to throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain to make sure you get

a return trip to this most fascinating of cities.

You will then sail away to visit **Marseille** which is the second largest city in France after Paris.

Marseille was historically the most important trade centre in the region and functioned as the main trade port of the French Empire. Marseille is France's largest city on the Mediterranean coast and largest commercial port as well as a leading cruise and freight port.

You will then sail away to visit Barcelona, repare to be wowed by the creative genius of Gaudí, take time out along the stunning harbour, and get to know these sandy shorelines by the shimmering Mediterranean. Bars, beaches, boutiques and more...

You again set sail for the beautiful island of Mallorca one of Spain's Balearic Islands in the Mediterranean. It's known for beach resorts, sheltered coves, limestone mountains and Roman and Moorish remains. Capital Palma has nightlife, the Moorish Almudaina royal palace and 13th-century Santa María Cathedral.

Cheshire Wildlife Trust is calling on budding photographers to enter their wildlife photographs into a competition to win publication in its charity calendar for 2020.

Autoreview by Tony Yates

Keeping you motoring

Nissan Micra Tekna DCi 90



First off – I will happily admit I'm not a Nissan fan! Yes, they make some good cars – but they are not really for me and I have had these thoughts for many years, but recently I had the pleasure of testing the new Micra and I was pleasantly surprised just how good it was. I'm not kidding here folks – I think I may have seen the light. Now without any further waffle let's get on with this week's review and why I have your attention,

Power and Efficiency:

Fitted with a 1461cc diesel engine with 90PS @ 5000rpm, 220Nm of torque and a fantastic short shift 5-speed gearbox that gives you a good feel between gear changes. Also, give it the beans and you will get a healthy 0-62 time of around 11.9sec and an impressive 61.4mpg (combined) which I managed very

easily - along with a top speed of around111mph, which is decent by all accounts. The engine is also happy to be driven hard to get the best out of it. But, I do have one niggle - in that it sounded a little noisy - but then it's a diesel so I can forgive it for that.

On the road:

Like all Micra models – they handle like a go-cart and I can feel where Nissan has made some major changes over the older Micra model because everything feels so much more together - which all helps in giving you a lot of confidence into the bends even when full to capacity – as well as giving you a great ride on uneven surfaces. Even on the motorway, all was good, and the road noise at high speed was very minimal.

Design & Technology

As with all Nissan's, the interior is of a good standard - but, I feel Nissan could have made it feel a little

less 'cheap'. Of course - it will last for years, and the seating is rather good - even after a long journey. Plus, all the dials and switches are laid out very well and are very clear and precise but there are areas I would like to see some improvements.

Some of the standard equipment across the range includes; ABS with EBD and Brake Assist, Driver, passenger, side and curtain airbags, front and rear seatbelts warning light, speed limiter, Tyre Pressure Monitoring System(TPMS), Intelligent trace control, Intelligent ride control, ISOFIX child seat anchorage points (rear x2 and front passenger seat*), Hill Start Assist, Intelligent Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Recognition, High-Beam Assist, Lane Departure Warning, Intelligent Lane Intervention, Automatic hazard lights, Halogen headlights with signature finisher, concealed rear door handles, LED signature Daytime Running Lights (DTRL), rear roof spoiler and door mirrors with turn indicator.



FRIENDS OF HADLOW STATION UPDATE

Relaying the rail track has now been completed. This has come in at a total cost of around $\pounds 9{,}500.$

This cost covers all the new sleepers, plus the new pieces of rail track and rail fittings that extends alongside the signal box, the ballast, and also the direct expenses incurred by Real Skills Training for getting their apprentices to/from Hadlow Road Station, etc, whilst the apprentices labour was provided free of charge. This has been a huge undertaking and much bigger than we realised when we started but we feel that the end product is well worth the effort put in by our superb maintenance team led by Tim and will last for another 40+ years all being well.

You will notice that more memorabilia signs have been installed around the station, (renovated and fitted by Andy). There is one inside the far shelter and also two "Way out" signs on the main platform. See if you can soot them.

Three more Rowan trees have been planted on the green space embankment behind the signal box to go alongside the two trees kindly donated and planted by Willaston Hey W.I.

Existing flagstones on this section of the platform have been cleared (which is now much easier to walk along). A cost of £3,420 will be incurred to put edging stones down that match the far platform so budget prioritisation will need to be undertaken including agreement on how to spend the very kind £600 donation from South Wirral Rambling Club.

Garden maintenance has started up again now that the weather is improving and there are a lot of spring flowers showing. These will be supplemented with the £45 National Garden Gift Card donation received from Chester & North Wales Cyclists' Touring Club (Weds Group).



The Pop-up-cafe continues to be a great success thanks to your support, and the very hard work of all the catering team in planning and organising the food purchasing supported by other volunteers on serving duties when the pop-up café is open on Sundays.

The next pop-up cafe openings will be April 28th from 10.30am to 1.30pm.

We look forward to your continuing support and seeing you all once again.



Cod Parmesan with Zucchini Noodles

Serves: 4

Prep time: 15 minutes Cook time: 20 minutes

2 medium zucchini (5-6 ounces each), thinly sliced

1 tablespoon unsalted butter

teaspoon olive oil, salt and pepper, to taste

1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan cheese

1 1/2 tablespoons mayonnaise

1 teaspoon lemon juice

1/8 teaspoon dried basil

1/8 teaspoon dried oregano

1/8 teaspoon onion powder

4 cod fillets (4-6 ounces each)

2 tablespoons shredded Parmesan cheese, divided

In nonstick skillet, saute zucchini slices in butter and oil just until soft. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Keep warm.

Heat oven to broil setting. Mix grated Parmesan cheese, mayonnaise, lemon juice, basil, oregano and onion powder together. Add salt and pepper, to taste. Divide and spread topping onto the top of each fillet.

Place fillets on foil-lined broiler pan. Broil 5-7 inches from broiler element for 3 minutes, or until top is browned and bubbly. Reduce heat to 300 F and cook 3-5 more minutes. Cook until fish is opaque throughout.

To serve, place 1/4 of zucchini on each plate. Top with cod fillet and garnish with 1/2 tablespoon shredded cheese.



I BEAT TORVILL & DEAN REVEALS WIRRAL CARE HOME RESIDENT, 94

A Wirral care home resident has revealed that he competed against Jayne Torvill and Christopher Dean – and once beat them in a competition.

Derek Drury, 94, who lives at The Hazelwell, a residential, nursing, palliative and respite care home in Heswall, started roller dancing at the age of four, in Manchester and then as a teenager began ice dancing.

He said: "I started roller dancing very young because I didn't like football, and my mother was a roller dance teacher so it was a natural step. I met my wife on a skiing holiday and we spent many years ice dancing together at Silver Blades in Liverpool (now Planet Ice Widnes), and although she didn't dance with me competitively, she was very supportive of me competing.

"For many years I spent every Saturday at the Birmingham ice rink, and that's where I first met Torvill and Dean. I only did ice dancing, not figure skating, but I skated many times against Torvill and Dean, and I even beat them in one competition in Liverpool."

Derek is still well known in the ice dance world especially for his choreography work. In his later years, he was a highly respected judge in the England Championships as well as National Ice-Skating, judging to a gold standard. Staff at The Hazelwell recently took him to the Deeside Leisure Centre in Queensferry when he met up with friends and people he used to teach how to skate.

Derek added: "I always tried to give helpful advice to all the dancers after the shows. I love photography and after retiring as a judge I went on to spend many years at ice rinks taking photos of competing skaters."

The Hazelwell deputy care home manager Sue Ball said: "It's wonderful for us all to hear stories about Derek's ice-skating past. When we're all enjoying Dancing on Ice, he can fill us in on behind the scenes expert information. It's like having a celebrity in our midst!"
