Bridge Wellness Gardens making poppies for Remembrance Sunday

An Ellesmere Port-based charity that provides fresh organic vegetable boxes across the region is running a running a weekly group to reduce social isolation in people aged over fifty.

Bridge Wellness Gardens and Bridge Community Farms runs the group every Thursday afternoon.

The group take part in a number of craft activities from armchair yoga to African drumming sessions but this year decided to knit poppies and make wreathes for Remembrance Day. All proceeds will be donated to the Royal British Legion.

General Manager Clair Johnson said: "Our community farm is a fantastic place and we thought it would be a good idea to extend what we do to grow better lives by setting up a group to help to reduce social isolation in the over 50's.

"One regular had not left the house for two years due to illness and anxiety. She is now a regular attendee who claims her life was changed the day she joined us. She now has a good circle of friends and they meet outside of the club too. "Another lady joined and has become a regular volunteer in our Better Lives Café. We gave her training and she successfully completed her food hygiene certification.

"We have another lady with early onset dementia who attends both of our groups to keep her mind active. She says she feels less anxious and is finding she is coping better on a day to day basis.

"All attendees have become part of our ever-growing family and most use our facilities regularly and often meet up for breakfasts on Saturday mornings in our lovely cafe."

The Thursday group meets every week between 12-2pm. The session costs £3.50 and lunch is included. Bridge Wellness Gardens is based in Mill Lane, off Overpool Road, in Ellesmere Port.

Keeping you motoring

Kia XCeed 1.0T-GDi '2' ADAP



For me, the XCeed is one of the most comprehensively equipped models in the Ceed family. The new XCeed has an extensive package of comfort, convenience, connectivity and safety, which is why I like the new XCeed so much. This car makes a statement about the person you are. It also makes you feel happy when you drive it, and it makes you feel happy when you remember you have the assurance of the Kia brand right by your side. This alone will ensure you have many happy years of motoring.

Power and Efficiency:

The XCeed I had on test was powered by a 998cc 3 cylinder petrol engine that develops 118bhp and 172 Nm of torque which I have to say feels lively and is more than happy to blast down the motorway or rumble around on the urban towns. Actually, the XCeed exceeded all my expectations when it came to helping me save fuel and make my normal boring school run just that little bit easier. The XCeed also achieved 50 mpg on the combined cycle which was quite impressive. Maximum speed also comes in at around115mph, followed by a 0-62 time of 10.9s.

On the road:

Well, if I'm honest with you – I expected it to be good, and I wasn't disappointed. The ride height is just about right, as is the suspension setup. Kia always seems to get it just about right most of the time – and, I felt the ride quality in the XCeed was everything I wanted it to be. Now, for some, they might consider the ride to be a little on the 'firm' side – but to me, it felt sturdy and poised. No dramas to talk about, just a fantastic amount of grip in and out of every corner. Plus if you go in a little heavy, you can be assured the XCeed will keep you firmly planted to the tarmac ahead.

Design & Technology

On the inside, the interior is very good, and all the dials are easy to read. Plus all the vehicle controls are well set out. The seats are comfy and there was a nice finish to the interior. Yes, it's not perfect in some areas, but show me a car that gets everything right, and I will quit writing altogether. Plus I actually don't care if the plastic is a little rough to the touch - because for me it's about the package as a whole - and what the XCeed can offer the modern driver.

Plus, you do get some pretty decent equipment such as; cruise control with speed limiter, air conditioning, alarm system, electric windows all-round, keyless entry, automatic headlight control, LED bi-function projection headlights, LED daytime running lights, DAB radio, Bluetooth and an 8" audio display touchscreen system offering Android Auto & Apple CarPlay.

Plus; Vehicle Stability Management. This aids stability when braking and cornering by controlling the car's Electronic Stability Control if it detects a loss of traction. Then there are; six airbags, Land Keeping Assist, High Beam Assist, Hill Start Assist Control and Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist all included as standard.

To sum up:

I'm going to give the Kia XCeed four stars in this test, not only because I like how it looks on the outside, but also because Kia gives you big smiles for very little money.

HELPING HEDGEHOGS

If your dog has fleas – don't blame the hedgehogs in your garden. Hedgehog fleas can only survive by living on bedgehogs

If you've got a garden, hedgehogs are useful visitors. They will eat slugs, beetles, caterpillars and a variety of other insects.

To attract hedgehogs to your garden you can try providing a natural shelter using log, leaf and compost piles (always check before moving the pile or having a bonfire) or allow patches of bramble to grow up, creating 'wild' areas. You could also place a piece of board against a pile of bricks to form a type of bivouac or buy a purpose built hedgehog house.

Hedgehogs can travel around a mile every night so, to provide access to enclosed gardens, try cutting holes in fences, removing bricks from walls, or digging tunnels under the garden boundary.

This will allow local hogs to move freely in and out of your garden. Food and fresh water laid out between February and October will encourage visiting hedgehogs to return regularly. You could try leaving out food such as minced meat, fresh liver, tinned dog food (not fish-based), or even scrambled eggs. Remember to check and replace the food and water daily and dispose of food if not eaten.

Hedgehogs like milk but it may give them diarrhoea. So it's best to give hedgehogs plain, fresh water each night in a shallow bowl. They should never be given cows' milk.

Hedgehog friendly gardening... GARDEN PONDS can be death traps to small animals – make sure there is always an easy route for hedgehogs to climb out of the water. Steps built out of house brick or wire mesh are often used in ponds. Alternatively, make sure the pond has a gentle slope on at least one side. Ideally, swimming pools should have shallow steps and a tight-fitting insulating cover should be used overnight. Remember to check your pond or pool every day!

STRIMMERS should be used sparingly under hedges and in other areas of undergrowth and always make sure you check any areas you want to cut or strim before starting – hedgehogs and other animals are likely to be resting there during the day.

DRAINS and similar open holes frequently trap unwary hedgehogs and they can starve if they are not rescued. Keep all drain covers in good condition and cover any open holes.

LITTER is a real hazard – hedgehogs frequently get their heads stuck in tins, plastic bags, binders from drinks cans or discarded yoghurt pots – make sure you dispose of your rubbish safely. Bin bags left on the ground will also attract hedgehogs, they might try to nest in them and get put out with the rubbish!

NETS particularly those used for tennis, football or cricket, must be furled well above the ground when not in use – hedgehogs often get entangled and die of starvation. Fruit nets are a similar source of danger but can be kept taut to stop animals getting entangled. Make sure all barbed wire is also kept off the ground.



AN Elegant HOLIDAY FEAST

here is no time like the holiday season to get together and make memories with family and friends. Nothing brings people together quite like an elegant meal featuring a standout main dish – an exceptionally prepared Entrée that pays true homage to the season and all that you celebrate. This focal point dish should not only look delightful, but needs to also be a masterful presentation of mouthwatering flavour to keep your loved ones gathered around the table.

Prime Rib Roast with Rosemary and Thyme au Jus

Serves: 10-14 Prep time: 30 minutes Total cook time: 3 hours, 50 minutes

- 6 pound Steaks Bone-In Prime Rib Roast
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1/2 cup Steaks Private Reserve Rub
 - 5 carrots, chopped into 1-inch pieces
 - 5 celery stalks, chopped into 1-inch pieces
 - 1 medium onion, chopped into 1-inch pieces
- $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cups red wine
 - 3 cups low-sodium beef broth
- 1 1/2 teaspoons fresh rosemary, finely chopped
- 1 1/2 teaspoons fresh thyme, finely chopped



Thaw roast completely (3-4 days for 6-pound roast) in refrigerator before cooking.

Heat oven to 250 F. Remove roast from packaging and pat dry with clean paper towels.

Coat outside of roast with olive oil and liberally season with rub. Place carrots, celery and onion in even layer on bottom of large roasting pan to catch beef drippings.

Place roast in roasting pan on elevated wire rack. Sprinkle any leftover rub on roast to ensure a generous coating.

Roast until roast reaches an internal temperature of 125 F (for medium-rare), approximately 3 hours for 6-pound roast.

Remove roast from oven and let rest 20-30 minutes. Meanwhile, heat broiler to high, with rack positioned for roast to sit about 4 inches from heating element.

After roast has rested, place in oven under broiler, fat side up, about 5 minutes to brown roast.

Remove pan from oven. Remove wire rack with roast from pan and place on carving board. Skim fat from pan, if necessary.

Place pan on top of stove over two burners set on high heat. Add wine to pan drippings and cook over high heat until reduced by half, releasing drippings on bottom of pan with wooden spoon or whisk. Add beef broth and cook until reduced by half again.

Whisk or stir in rosemary and thyme. Strain out vegetables and pour au jus into serving vessel.

Slice roast and serve with au jus.

Hi! My name is Bex and I am one of the Physics in the Clinical Therapy Team at Claire House. Although we are based in the Hospice, we are a bit of a nomadic bunch as we often support our children and families out in the community.

It would be difficult to describe a "normal day" as they all vary so much, which is why I still love my job so much after 10 years! First up, I find out if any of

the children in the hospice need any respiratory care. Helping the children breathe, the best they can, is top of our priority list. Throughout the day I work with the care team to use different pieces of equipment, to give the children a break from their wheekhair, keeping them safe and comfortable but giving their body a well needed move and stretch.

For the team, taking children in the hydrotherapy pool is a big part of the day. This might be a fun swim with disco lights and blasting music, a relaxing, therapoutic session to help reduce pain and discomfort, or supporting a family splash which allows families to have fun and make lots of amazing memories together! Families will sometimes ask to take their child in the pool when they are near end of life. During the worst time of their lives, they somehow manage to smile.

As a team we really do our best to help the children and families enjoy the time they have together and make the most of life.


The party atmosphere will be back once more on December 7, with all staff and residents' families coming together for Christmas carols and a festive singalong for all to enjoy.
