



 Light up a Life for Wirral Hospice St John's

Wirral Hospice St John's Light up a Life, a part of Wirral life since 1996, will be very different this year making it, in many ways, even more poignant.

From early December, 10,000 beautiful lights will shine out from the trees around the hospice gardens in the run up to and during Christmas, offering the people of Wirral an uplifting and meaningful way, to remember family and friends who are no longer with us.

Support is needed more than ever, which is why the hospice is inviting everyone, individuals and businesses, to sponsor a light to remember their loved ones and to help fund the hospice's cherished medical and nursing services.

Regrettably, due to the COVID-19 restrictions and to keep everyone safe, the hospice has made the difficult decision to cancel the annual outdoor Light up a Life switch-on service, which sadly includes the viewing of loved one's names in the hospice Books of Honour. People who sponsor a light also have the name of the person they are remembering entered into the specially produced books which, for this year, will be available to view online while a personal copy can be pre-ordered for viewing at home.

A Light up a Life card with a personalised greeting will be sent out to all who request one and there is also the opportunity to buy a metallic silver star tree decoration keepsake inscribed with the words, 'Light up a Life'.

The hospice is endeavouring to reach out to even more families across Wirral this winter, with a pre-recorded service which will be available to view from the comfort of their own homes, via the hospice's website, from 6pm on Sunday 6th December. The short film will capture the spirit of the lights switch-on, interspersed with carols from a socially-distanced hospice choir featuring locally renowned singer, Sarah Mullis. It will also contain the recollections of people whose families have experienced the hospice's dedicated care as well as heartfelt thoughts and readings from the hospice team, including some wonderful volunteers.

Julia Evans, the hospice's Fundraising Development Manager said, "For the past 24 years Light up a Life has brought people together to remember our loved ones and reflect the loss we all feel, especially around Christmas time. In these unique and challenging times we are so grateful that our Wirral community is continuing to support the hospice. We would normally have the company of around two thousand people at the lights switch-on and we're going to miss everyone so much this year. We really cannot thank people enough as they continue to make their kind and thoughtful donations for Light up a Life which makes a massive contribution to the specialist care the hospice provides to our patients and their family and friends."

The founder of Bridge Community Farms has been made an MBE in the Queen's birthday honours.

Francis Ball has been recognised for his services to the community in Ellesmere Port during Covid-19.

The list, which also honours medical staff, key workers and volunteers responding to the pandemic, was due to have been announced on the Queen's official birthday in June. It was delayed because of the coronavirus and will now be published on Saturday.

Francis established Bridge Community Farms CIC in Ellesmere Port in 2014. The 10-acre farm grows vegetables, salad and fruit using organic methods and sells organically grown delivered vegetable boxes throughout the Wirral and West Cheshire.

The charity also provides support and a therapeutic environment for those with mental health and life-long learning difficulties as well as work experience for young people and the long-term unemployed.

The charity launched a dedicated service to help vulnerable and elderly people during the pandemic so they could continue to receive vital provisions.

They recruited 30 extra volunteers including drivers to help with the distribution of their popular weekly vegetable boxes after a fourfold increase in enquiries from older people confined to home and worried about getting fresh food. A Bridge Buddy Club was launched to help vulnerable customers who were feeling isolated, lonely or anxious at home. A Bridge Buddy would call them for a chat as often as they liked.

They also produced nearly 10,000 free meals for struggling families during the school holidays, delivered to their home by Chester charity Passion-for-Learning.

Staff also worked hard to maintain the farm's growing spaces and tend to plants and crops to meet the demand of the vegetable boxes.

Francis said: " I am greatly humbled to receive this honour, knowing how many "Bridge Community Farms" and "Bridge Community Wellness Gardens" colleagues, both volunteers and paid staff, have worked so hard through the pandemic to bring fresh food and some comfort and support to so many people across The Wirral, Chester and West Cheshire.

"We love what we do and we love the responses from our thousands of Veg Box customers, Wellness clients, volunteers and supporters. And we are deeply grateful to our major funders, The Steve Morgan Foundation, Cheshire Community Foundation, Stanlaw Abbey Development Trust, Cheshire Freemasons, The Earl of Chester Fund, The Ursula Keyes Trust and many others for making our work possible."

Bridge Community Farms CIC, part of the Bridge Community Wellness Gardens CIO, supports people with life-long learning disabilities and mental health issues. We have a 10 acre farm in Ellesmere Port where we offer outdoor study facilities and work experience for young people who struggle in an academic environment, and a variety of activities for the local community. The gardens contain raised beds, several polytunnels, a craft centre, farm shop and café. The farm delivers organically grown veg boxes across The Wirral and West Cheshire. Bridge Community Wellness Gardens work in many areas in the community such as sending out meal kits to those in need, and offering weekly phone calls to those living alone, through the Bridge Buddy Club.

## Keeping you motoring

### Subaru BRZ 2.0i SE Lux 6-speed manual



In light of the Coronavirus and being unable to test any new vehicles at this moment in time, I have decided we should revisit the review of Subaru BRZ I did a while back.

There are few words that explain the BRZ in full detail such as; dynamic, sophisticated and thrilling – and I still believe this to be true even now.

With its low centre of gravity, rear-wheel drive and taut chassis – it's still able to deliver exceptional road handling which in essence is why I still love the BRZ in every way.

You can still buy a BRZ of course, they are still around – and loved by many, not only because it looks stunning, but because it feels like a proper drivers car. Even now a few years on – I can still feel that tingle. Before you read on, I just wanted to say; Please stay at home & stay safe. We will all get through this, but it's going to take a while.

#### **Power and Efficiency:**

Fitted with a 2.0-litre horizontally-opposed (Boxer), four-cylinder, four-stroke (DOHC 16V) petrol engine with 200PS @ 7000rpm and 205Nm of torque. 0-62mph is around 7.6sec, fuel consumption is a decent 33.3 mpg combined and a top speed of around 140mph.

For all those tech nerds out there - the engine's pistons are placed 180 degrees apart allowing a lower, flatter engine profile. This gives the powerplant - and therefore the whole car- a lower centre of gravity. This more balanced weight distribution gives the BRZ exceptional handling, poise and more importantly control.

Boxer engines have taken some stick in the past, but, they fascinate me and the Boxer engine in the BRZ is pretty cool, thanks to key features such as the engine's square bore and stroke (86mm x 86mm), which all helps achieve a balance between mechanical efficiency, environmental performance, speed and power.

The engine is also fitted with an intelligent port injection system, which selects the appropriate fuel injection rate to provide greater fuel efficiency and lower emissions - all wonderful stuff then!

#### On the road:

Nimble, frisky and if I am being honest, a little minx – and that's just to get you started. Take the nimble BRZ out on the road and you will feel how well it grips as I said earlier on in this review. Again, all thanks to the BRZ being fitted with a Torsen limited-slip rear differential for improved traction, allowing the more enthusiastic driver to make the most of the car's rearwheel-drive layout.

Also, using a rear-wheel-drive sports car drivetrain allows the engine to sit further back in the BRZ chassis, which helps provide a perfect balance for precise control and grip during high-speed cornering. The BRZ is also fitted with a quick-ratio steering system – tuned to react instantly to every input, which makes it feel like a proper racer.

Of course, to get the best out of a sports car you need to have a front-engined, rear-wheel-drive layout – and the BRZ has this by the bucket load.

For 2020, there have been some changes, and although very small – they all make a big difference. Sometimes when you have the perfect balance between man and machine, it's not worth trying to perfect it more – especially when you got it right the first time around.

#### Interior and Technology:

First off - I'm so glad to see that the designers at Subaru have paid a lot of attention to the detail inside the cabin of the BRZ - thankfully its refreshing and modern. Also, the seats are comfy once you get the correct adjustment. When it comes to the boot - the space is OK for a large suitcase or your golf clubs. If I'm being honest, you will be very surprised just how much you can fit in.

#### On the inside:

Some of the additional standard equipment on the BRZ includes; Subaru Boxer engine (2.0-litre petrol), Rear-Wheel Drive, Track Mode function, Torsen® Limited Slip Differential, LED headlights, Keyless Entry & Push Button Start System, 7" multi-function colour touchscreen with Apple CarPlay<sup>™</sup> and Android Auto<sup>™</sup> and Satellite navigation.

What can I say – the BRZ is a great drive and perfect for someone who wants a nimble little sports car.




Almond & Aubergine Stew with Basil Couscous

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat your oven to 200°C. Put the **water** (amount specified in the ingredient list) on to boil in a large saucepan on medium heat. Add the **vegetable stock pot** and stir to dissolve. Remove the root and dark green tops from the **leek**, cut in half lengthways and thinly slice into half moons. Peel and grate the **garlic** (or use a garlic press). Halve, peel and finely chop the **red onion** into ½cm pieces.

Add the **couscous** to your pan of stock, remove from the heat and pop on a lid. Set it aside until everything else is ready. Halve the **aubergine** lengthways and chop into 1cm pieces. Put on a baking tray, drizzle over some **olive oil** and season with a pinch of **salt**. Toss to coat then spread out evenly and roast on the top shelf of your oven until soft and brown, 20 mins.



- Add the green olives, a pinch of salt and a few grinds of black pepper to the stew. Once the aubergine is cooked, add that in too along with the ground almonds.
- Pick the **basil leaves** from their stalks and finely chop (discard the **stalks**). Take the lid off the couscous and fluff it up with a fork. Stir through three-quarters of the **basil**.
- Serve the **couscous** with the **aubergine stew** on top. Crumble over the **feta** and sprinkle on the remaining **basil**.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER



### NOVEMBER 22, 1963: DEATH OF THE PRESIDENT

Shortly after noon on November 22, 1963, President John F. Kennedy was assassinated as he rode in a motorcade through Dealey Plaza in downtown Dallas, Texas.

Crowds of excited people lined the streets and waved to the Kennedys. The car turned off Main Street at Dealey Plaza around 12:30 p.m. As it was passing the Texas School Book Depository, gunfire suddenly reverberated in the plaza.

Bullets struck the president's neck and head and he slumped over toward Mrs. Kennedy. The governor was shot in his back.

### NOVEMBER 17, 2003: THE FIRST TERM OF ARNOLD SCHWARZENEGGER AS GOVERNOR OF CALIFORNIA BEGAN ON

The first term of Arnold Schwarzenegger as Governor of California began on November 17, 2003, and ended on January 3, 2007.

The actor's romantic life also captured the attention of the American public: he married television journalist and lifelong Democrat Maria Shriver, niece of the late President John F. Kennedy, in 1986.

Born in Thal, Austria, on July 30, 1947, Arnold Schwarzenegger began body-building as a teenager. He won the first of four "**Mr. Universe**" bodybuilding championships at the age of 20, and moved to the United States in 1968.




#### NOVEMBER 5, 1605: THE PLAN WAS TO BLOW UP THE HOUSE OF LORDS DURING THE STATE OPENING OF PARLIAMENT

The Gunpowder Plot of 1605, in earlier centuries often called the Gunpowder Treason Plot or the Jesuit Treason, was a failed assassination attempt against King James I by a group of provincial English Catholics led by Robert Catesby.

The plot was revealed to the authorities in an anonymous letter sent to William Parker, 4th Baron Monteagle, on 26 October 1605. During a search of the House of Lords in the evening on 4 November 1605, Fawkes was discovered guarding 36 barrels of gunpowder—enough to reduce the House of Lords to rubble—and arrested. Most of the conspirators fled from London as they learned of the plot's discovery, trying to enlist support along the way.





NOVEMBER 26, 1922: CARTER AND FELLOW ARCHAEOLOGIST LORD CARNARVON ENTERED THE INTERIOR CHAMBERS OF THE TOMB, FINDING THEM MIRACULOUSLY INTACT. British archaeologist Howard Carter and his workmen discover a step leading to the tomb of King Tutankhamen in the Valley of the Kings in Egypt.

Thus began a monumental excavation process in which Carter carefully explored the fourroom tomb over several years, uncovering an incredible collection of several thousand objects. The most splendid architectural find was a stone sarcophagus containing three coffins nested within each other. Inside the final coffin, which was made out of solid gold, was the mummy of the boy-king Tutankhamen, preserved for more than 3,000 years. Most of these treasures are now housed in the Cairo Museum.

**NOVEMBER 11, 1992:** THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND VOTED TO ALLOW WOMEN TO BECOME PRIESTS.

NOVEMBER 27, 1975: ROSS MCWHIRTER, THE FOUNDER OF THE GUINNESS BOOK OF RECORDS AND AN OUTSPOKEN CRITIC OF THE IRA, IS MURDERED OUTSIDE HIS HOME BY MEMBERS OF THE PARAMILITARY GROUP.

NOVEMBER 4, 1979: PINK FLOYD RELEASE "THE WALL" THE 4TH IN THEIR SERIES OF MULTI AWARD WINNING CONCEPT ALBUMS "THE WALL" WHICH IS LATER MADE INTO A MOVIE.

NOVEMBER 30, 2007: STUNT RIDER EVEL KNIEVEL DIES AGED 69








Walk & Cycle the Wirral

There are lots of excellent walk or cycle rides that run along pleasant paths throughout the Wirral coast and countryside which are traffic free. One in particular follows the track bed of part of the former Birkenhead Railway route from Hooton at Hadlow Station along to West Kirby.

Start at Hooton Railway Station near Ellesemere Port and head towards Neston entering the beautiful Wirral Country Park on the way. The path then heads along the beautiful Wirral coastline passing Heswall and Thurstaston before finishing at West Kirby and Hoylake.

There are many beautiful views to take in, as you either walk or cycle along many of the paths that cover the Wirral. On a clear day you can see as far as Moel Famau across the Dee Estuary. Many wild animals nest along the track in the large hedgerows and a large variety of butterflys can be witnessed. Be sure to take plenty of drink and food although you will come across some of the most quaint pubs on the way. The walking guides, including Wirral's Circular Trail can be downloaded from the **Visitwirral** website.

### A FEW OF WIRRAL'S LANDMARKS ON THE JOURNEY Hadlow Station - Willaston





Leasowe Lighthouse A Grade II Listed Building Perch Rock Lighthouse -New Brighton

Wirral boasts many beautiful attractions to see and owes much of its once baron landline to its enterprising Benedictine monks who turned the headland into an enterprising and thriving estuary.

In 1330 Wirral developed a trade link across to Liverpool and established the first ferry crossing. The monks home at the time was Birkenhead Priory and Birkenhead and surrounding areas began to rise.

Hadlow Road railway station was a station on the single track Hooton to West Kirby branch of the Birkenhead Railway, on the Wirral Peninsula. The station served the village of Willaston.

Bidston Windmill built in about 1800 and continued working as a flour mill until about 1875. The previous structure, a wooden peg mill, was destroyed by fire in 1791.

Leasowe Lighthouse is the oldest brick built lighthouse in Britain built around 1763, by the Mersey Docks & Harbour Board.

Enjoy the walks and cycle trails around our beautiful Wirral coastlines.



# GARDENING JOBS FOR THE GARDEN AND GREENHOUSE

Autumn is without a doubt one of our most favourite times of the year. As the weather changes and turns crisp, it's the perfect excuse to get out for a walk and kick some leaves! And as our gardens welcome the change of the season by shredding its leaves, there is still plenty to be getting on with in order to prepare your garden for the colder winter months, and the spring ahead.

# Out in the garden

Although the fallen leaves can look spectacular and make a fun play area for young children, it's important to not let them sit on your lawn for too long as they will prevent the amount of sunlight from reaching the lawn, so be sure to rake these up on a regular basis. If you want to help your local wild animals, you could make a mound out of your raked leaves and help provide a winter bed for some of your little visitors.

Plant out your winter bedding plants and add some colour and interest to your garden during the colder days.



Raise your containers now to prevent possible waterlogging later.

If it's mild where you are and your lawn is still growing, trim it back but set your mower blades to a higher setting. There is still time to give your lawn its Autumn feed, choose one which is high in potassium and phosphorous as this will help to establish a strong root system and harden your grass ready for the cooler weather.

Clean out and fill up your bird feeders. This will help encourage winter birds into your garden. You should also ensure your bird baths are clean and topped up.

Think about moving your plants into your greenhouse or garage to protect them against winter frost.


